EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-04-19-02 COMPARTMENT 57 MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL CLOSURE

Pursuant to the authorities in 36 CFR. Part 261(a) and (b), and 36 CFR § 261.53(e) and (f), and ongoing trail construction, I am closing the following areas to all recreational use:

- AREA CLOSED:** Segments of the Mountain Bike Trails located within Compartment 57 shown as closed on the attached map, located in Walker County, Texas. Persons are advised to adhere to all signage posted within Compartment 57 regarding closures.
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Closure Order is effective March 18, 2019 and continues until rescinded.
- PROHIBITED ACTS:** No person or vehicle may enter, go into or be upon or within any part of the Segments of the Mountain Bike Trails located within Compartment 57 shown as closed on the attached map.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any Federal, State, or local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- (2) Emergency crews who are repairing or restoring utility services; and
- (3) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

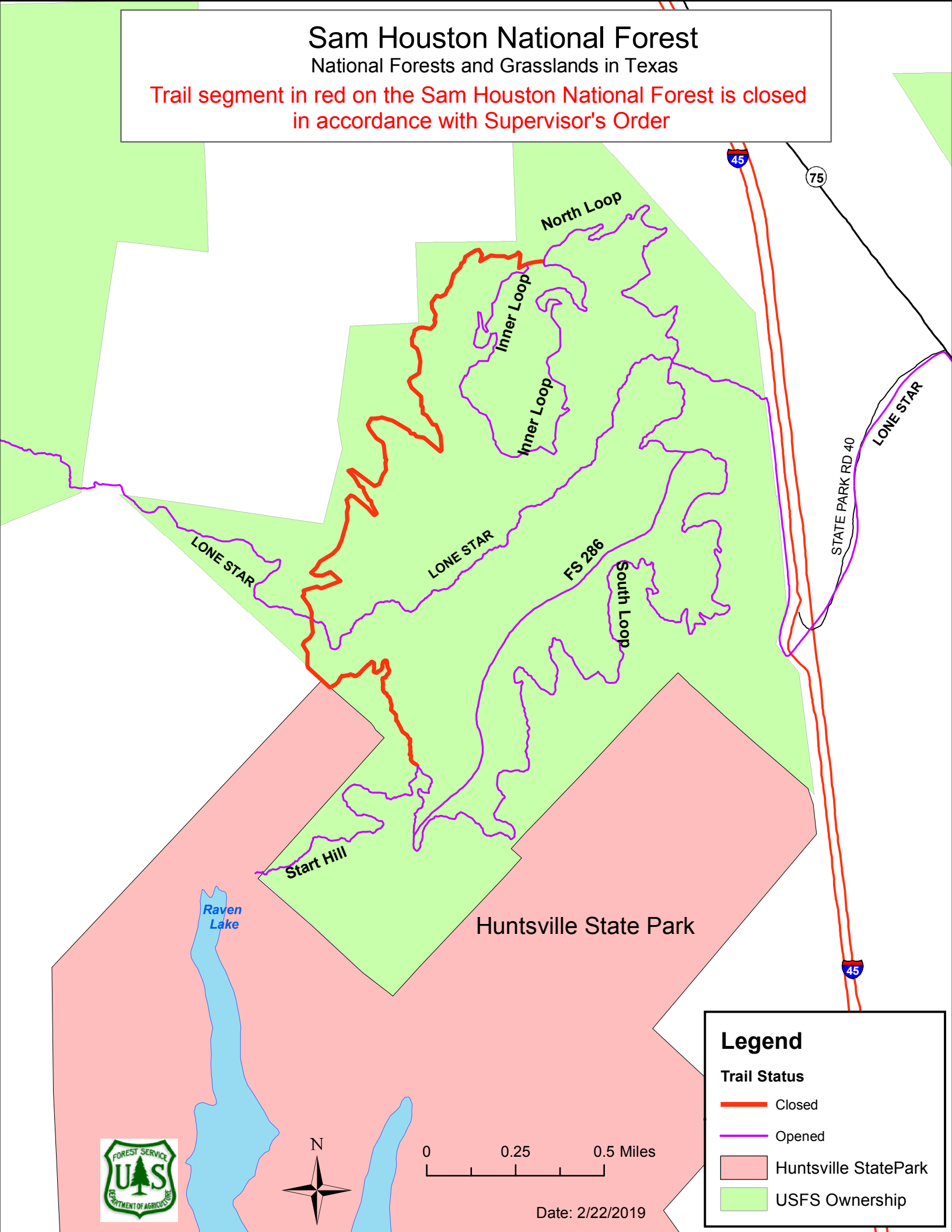
