SAN BERNARDINO NATIONAL FOREST Forest Order No. 05-12-55-18-01 Cranston Fire Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the San Jacinto Ranger District of the San Bernardino National Forest. This Order is effective from **December 15, 2018** through **July 31, 2019**.

- 1. Going into or being upon any National Forest System lands within the Cranston Fire Closure Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
- 2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Cranston Fire Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
- 3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Cranston Fire Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- 2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
