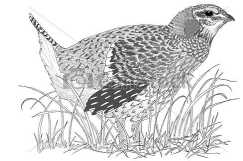


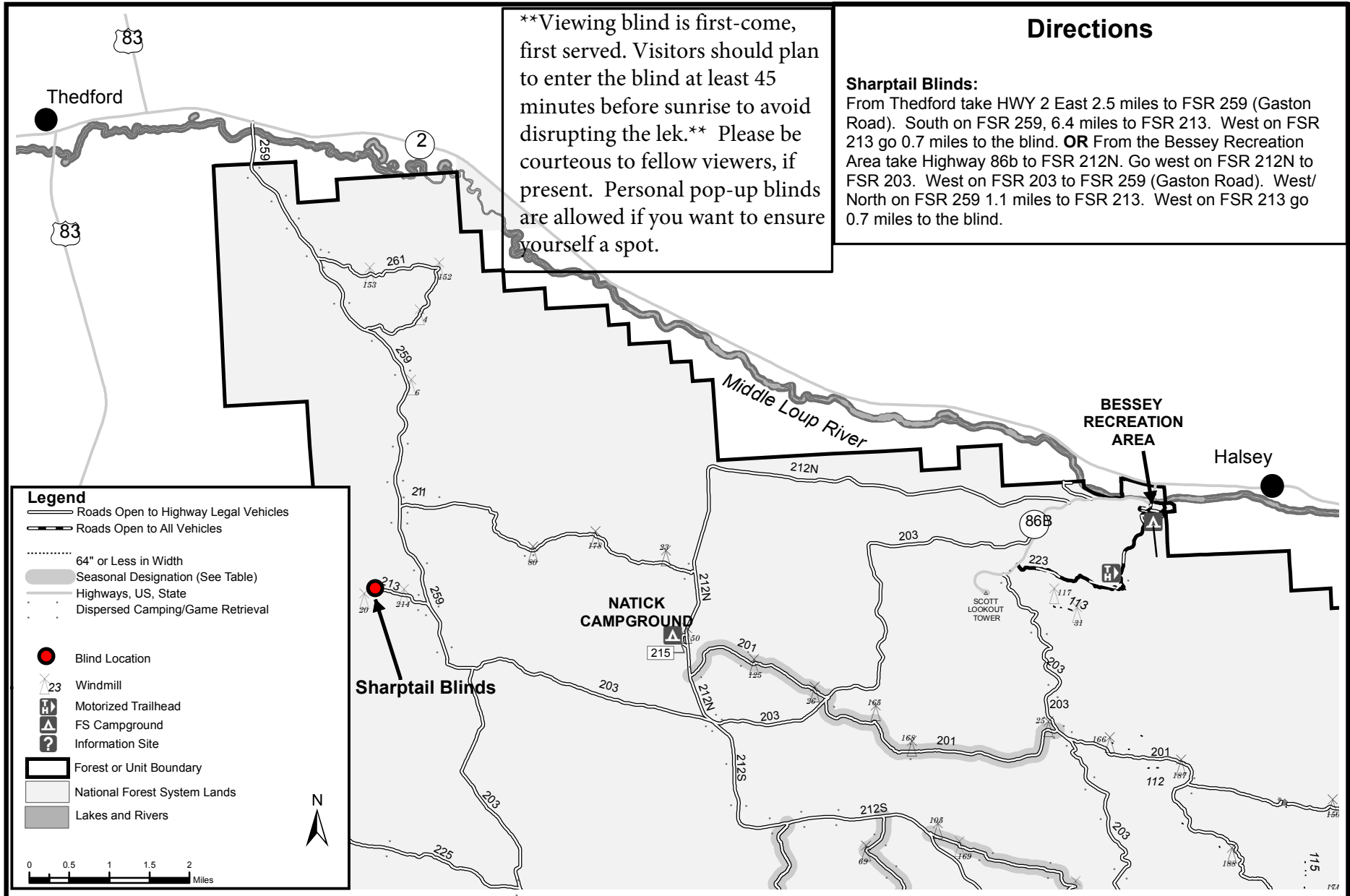

****Viewing blind is first-come, first served. Visitors should plan to enter the blind at least 45 minutes before sunrise to avoid disrupting the lek.** Please be courteous to fellow viewers, if present. Personal pop-up blinds are allowed if you want to ensure yourself a spot.**

Directions

Sharp-tail Blinds:
 From Thedford take HWY 2 East 2.5 miles to FSR 259 (Gaston Road). South on FSR 259, 6.4 miles to FSR 213. West on FSR 213 go 0.7 miles to the blind. **OR** From the Bessey Recreation Area take Highway 86b to FSR 212N. Go west on FSR 212N to FSR 203. West on FSR 203 to FSR 259 (Gaston Road). West/North on FSR 259 1.1 miles to FSR 213. West on FSR 213 go 0.7 miles to the blind.
