## **Objections:**

- The Forest Service has not taken a hard look at how the revised Land Management Plan would align with the agency's 2010 National Roadmap for Responding to Climate Change, which includes guidance to:
  - Assess vulnerability of species and ecosystems to climate change
  - Restore resilience
  - Promote carbon sequestration
  - Connect habitats, restore important corridors for fish and wildlife, decrease fragmentation and remove impediments to species migration.
- The Environmental Impact Statement fails to provide comprehensive estimates of the total amount of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) or other greenhouse gas emissions caused by Forest Service management actions and policies – forest-wide, regionally, or nationally.
