

Management Indicator and Surrogate Species

Eligible Objectors & Interested Persons for this issue:

Objections:

- Surrogate species identified in the revised Land Management Plan (LMP) also act as Management Indicator Species (MIS). However, the term "MIS" or "Management Indicator Species" does not occur anywhere in the Land Management Plan; only the term surrogate species is used. This creates confusion.
- The draft LMP does not contain plan components for "Region 6 sensitive species, state-listed species, or other species" whose vulnerability has been identified in the published literature.

Resolution Options Proposed by Objectors: None

There were no resolution options proposed by objectors on this issue, therefore, it will not be discussed at the Objection Resolution Meeting. The issue is being reviewed by the Reviewing Officer and will be addressed in the response to objections.
