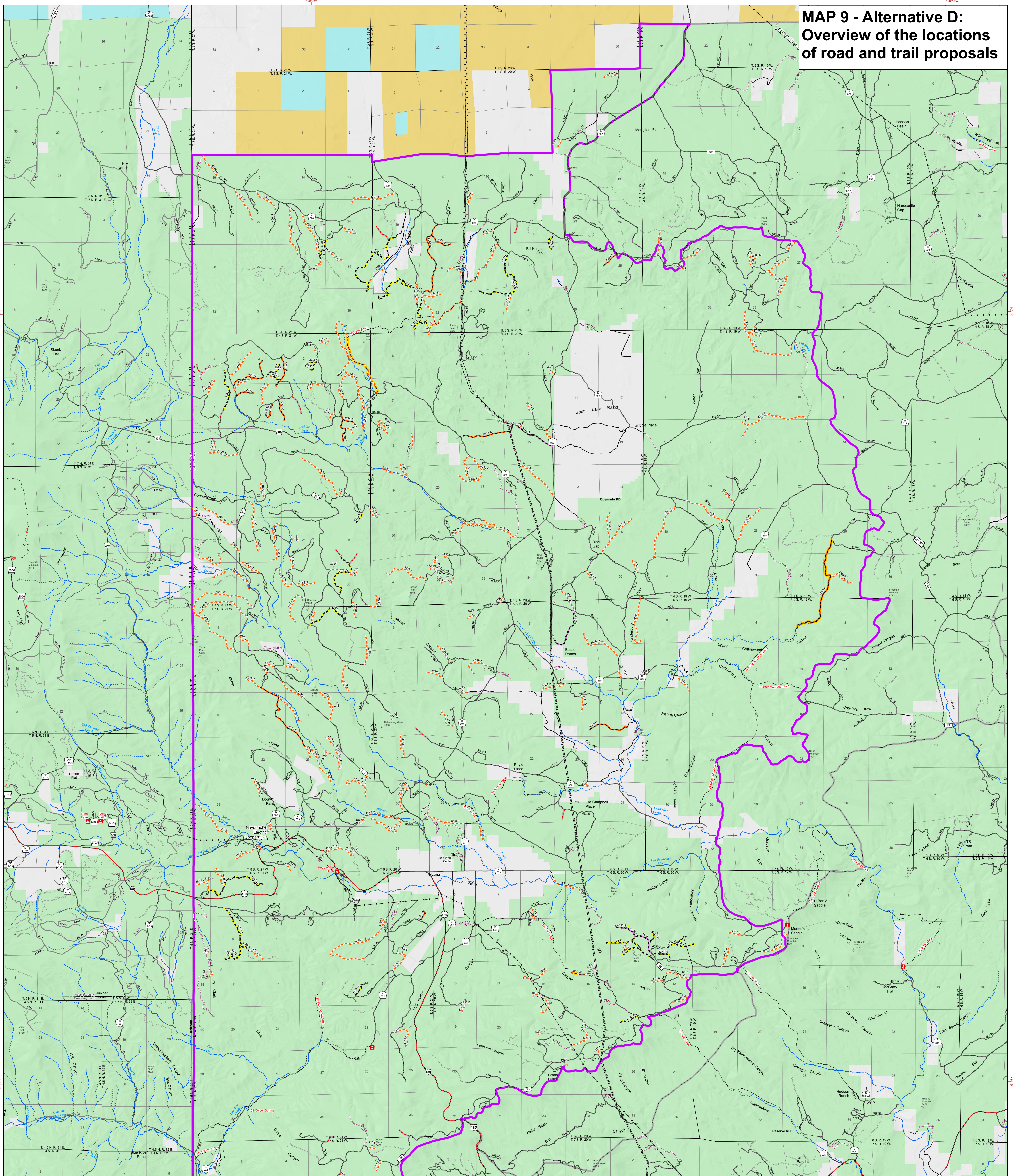


MAP 9 - Alternative D: Overview of the locations of road and trail proposals



Alternative D: Luna Planning Motorized proposals

- - - Reopen NFS Maintenance level 1 closed roads for administrative or permitted use for proposed treatment and activities and close after activities are completed
- - - Reopen NFS Maintenance level 1 closed roads for administrative or permitted use for proposed treatment and activities and decommission after activities are completed
- - - Reopen closed roads for periodic administrative use or by written authorization only (TEP)
- - - Add user created route and designate as administrative use or written authorization only (TEP)
- - - Road Decommissioning
- - - Leave hiking/foot trail tread during decommissioning/closing of roads
- - - Construct Temporary Roads - obliterate after vegetation treatments are completed
- - - Luna Planning Area (185,586 ac.)
