Camping and Food Restriction

Pursuant to CFR, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the prohibition hereinafter set forth applies to National Forest System Road #25 (Clark Creek Road) on the Unaka Ranger District, within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map. This closure order is in effect until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

- 1. Camping within 300 feet of both sides of FSR #25 from the Forest Service boundary to the end of the road. **36 CFR 261.58e.**
- 2. Preparing and cooking food within 300 feet of both sides of FSR #25 from the Forest Service boundary to the end of the road. **36 CFR 261.58cc.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or Firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
