Forest Development Roads and Trails – Use of a Bicycle on Trails Not Designated

Pursuant to Title 16, United States Code (U.S.C.) §551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) §261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land on the Sulphur Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest, Grand County, State of Colorado as listed in included Attachments.

This Order restricts bicycle use to designated routes on roads and trails on the entire Sulphur Ranger District. This is necessary to provide for reduced user conflicts and increased resource protection. Designated Routes for bicycles on Trails are listed in Attachment A & Routes for bicycles on Roads currently closed to Motor Vehicle Use is listed in Attachment B. Designated Routes for bicycles on Roads currently open to Motor Vehicle Use is allowed year-round as shown on the Sulphur Ranger District “2011 North half Motor Vehicle Map” and the “2011 South Half Motor Vehicle Map”

PROHIBITIONS:

When provided by an order, the following are prohibited:


1. Use of any type of traffic or mode of transport prohibited by the order. 36 CFR §255.(c)
 - A. No bicycles may be operated on any roads or trails on the Sulphur Ranger District off Designated Routes (Roads and Trails).
 - B. No bicycles may be operated on Forest Service Trail #N68 (Tipperary Creek) or Forest Service Trail #N82 (Flume) from December 15th 2019 to May 15th.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission (36 CFR §261.50(e)(1))
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty (36 CFR §261.50(e)(4))

Done in Fort Collins, CO. This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded or December 31, 2024, whichever occurs first.

Violations of these regulations are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months or both (16 USC §551, 18 USC 3571).
