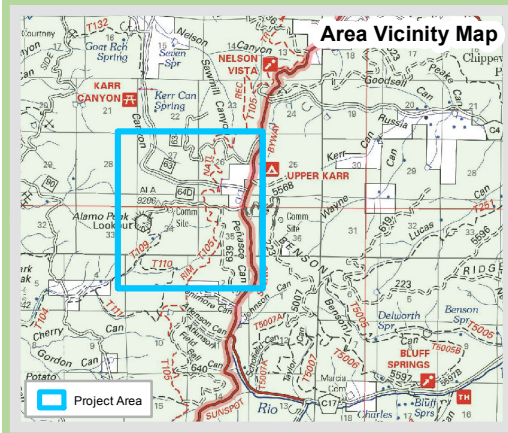
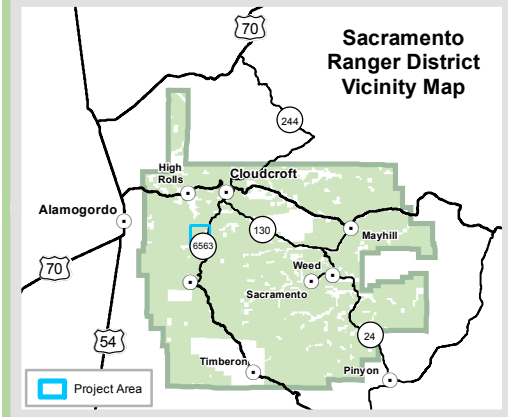

ALAMO PEAK FUELWOOD AREA



To access the area, from Cloudcroft travel south on NM130 for approximately 2 miles, then turn right (southwest) onto NM6563 (Sunspot Highway). Continue for approximately 6 miles then turn right onto Alamo Peak Road (FR 64D). Continue for 0.2 miles where the fuelwood area will be visible on both sides of the road.

There are orange fuelwood area signs in place. Fuelwood area extends for about 2.5 miles to the west.

Fuelwood Type: Dead and down mixed conifer, pine and aspen in piles.

Avoid area when wet. High clearance vehicle recommended.

Do NOT cut dead or green standing trees.
