Veery	<i>Flute-like, down the drain</i>
Ovenbird	<i>Teacher teacher teacher teacher teacher (soft to loud)</i>
White-throated sparrow	<i>Poor Sam Peabody Peabody Peabody</i>
Yellowthroat Warbler	<i>Witchity Witchity Witchity</i>
Red-winged Blackbird	<i>Konk-la-ree</i>
Alder Flycatcher	<i>Quick! Free beer!</i>
Indigo Bunting	<i>Fire fire where where here here</i>
Wood Duck	<i>What? What? What?</i>
Least Flycatcher	<i>Chebek</i>
