



Target Shooting

DO... Practice safe gun handling by treating every gun as if it is loaded.

DO... Use approved targets along with a safe, "bullet-proof" backstop. Do NOT attach your targets to vegetation or structures, such as trees, log decks, slash piles, fences or water tanks.

DO... Keep your finger off of the trigger until your sights are on the target and you are ready to shoot.

DO... Make sure of your target and what is beyond.

DO... Properly dispose of all garbage, including targets, paper, cans, bottles and appliances.

DO NOT... Use exploding targets as they are prohibited on Kaibab National Forest and everywhere within the Southwestern Region.

DO NOT... Point the muzzle of a firearm at anything you do not intend to shoot.

DO NOT... Be in possession of alcoholic beverages while discharging a firearm.

DO NOT... Target shoot within 150 yards of a residence, building, campsite, developed recreation area or occupied area.

DO NOT... Target shoot across or on a national forest road or body of water.

DO NOT... Target shoot into or within a cave.

DO NOT... Use tracer bullets or incendiary ammunition.

DO NOT... Disturb, destroy, or in any way damage any prehistoric, historic, or archaeological resource, structure, site, artifact or property.
