## Prevent Wildfires While Target Shooting

- Avoid shooting into rocks and dry grass.
- If fire danger is high, consider shooting at an established outdoor or indoor range.
- Put targets against an earthen backstop and away from all flammable vegetation.
- Don't shoot with steel core ammo.
- Exploding targets, tracer ammo and incendiary ammo are illegal on public lands.
- Don't shoot trash like TVs or other appliances.
- Don't smoke or park near dry grass.
- Watch the target area for signs of fire for at least 30 minutes.
