

Forest Stewardship Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands


Forest Stewardship Program

This program provides technical assistance to private landowners in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands for the development of management plans that promote sustainable management of forest resources. Partner institutions for this program include the Puerto Rico Department of Natural and Environmental Resources Forest Service Bureau, and the U.S. Virgin Islands Department of Agriculture.

At State and Private Forestry at the International Institute of Tropical Forestry we assist in connecting the landowners with partners that manage programs that could help in the management plan implementation.

Together with the Departament of Natural and Environmental Resources (DNER) in Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands Department of Agriculture, we have worked with different collaborators such as Cafiesencia, Centro para la Conservación del Paisaje and Protectores de Cuencas, among others.






Puerto Rico—**43** plans managing **7,415** acres
