Antelope Lake Recreation Area / Elev. 5000'

Antelope Lake is one of the more remote, quiet lakes on the forest. From Taylorsville, take the Antelope Lake Road 23 miles to the lake. From Janesville, take County Rd. 208 for 4 miles, FS road 28N01 for 9 miles, turn right on FS road 28N03 for 2 miles. **Supplies** including groceries, ice, bait, and souvenirs are available from Memorial Day-Labor Day. There is an extra vehicle fee at individual campsites.

Boulder Campground

- 68 sites, tent/trailer/RV
- some sites are reservable

Lone Rock Campground

- 87 sites, tent/trailer/RV
- some sites are reservable

Bucks Lake Recreation Area/

Elev. 5000' - 5400'

Located 32 miles northeast of Oroville on Oro-Quincy Hwy, or 17 miles west of Quincy on Oro-Quincy Hwy. Bucks Lake is a high mountain lake surrounded by the Bucks Lake Wilderness on one side and recreation residences/resorts on the other side. Showers are available nearby at Sandy Point Day Use/Boat Launch. **Supplies** and **boat rentals** are available at nearby resorts. There is an extra vehicle fee at individual campsites.

Whitehorse Campground

- 19 sites tent/trailer, first come-first serve only
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- 3 Equestrian campsites (no corrals)
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes at some sites

Sundew Campground

- 22 sites tent/trailer, some sites are reservable
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes

Mill Creek Campground

- 10 units, tent/trailer, some sites are reservable
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- water, vault toilet, bear boxes

Lower Bucks Campground

- 7 units for tent/trailers with self-contained sewage storage
- first come first served

- 11 units tent/trailers, some sites are reservable

Feather River Canyon Area / Elev. 2300'-2600'

Located 32 miles west of Quincy on Hwy 70, Gansner Bar, North Fork, and Queen Lily are located on the North Fork of the Feather River along Caribou Road. Hallsted is located along the Feather River on Hwy 70 just 17 miles west of Quincy. Supplies are available in Belden, Twain, and Quincy. Extra vehicle fees are charged at individual sites.

Gansner Bar Campground lies on the west branch of the North Fork of the Feather River

North Fork Campground

Located 17 miles west of Quincy on Hwy 70, near Twain.

- 20 units, tent/trailer, some sites reservable

Spanish Creek Campground

Off Hwy. 70, 8 miles west of Quincy. Supplies available in Quincy.

- 21 units, tent/trailer, some sites reservable
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- Water, vault toilets, bear boxes

Spanish Creek Group Campground

- 3 units - reservations only
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- 25 people per site
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes

Greenville Campground

Located 1 mi. north of Greenville, on Hwy 89, 9 miles SE of Lake Almanor

- 19 units - first come-first serve

Other Mt. Hough Campgrounds

The following campgrounds have no piped water and all have vault toilets. Trailer space is available with the exception of Silver Lake. Extra vehicle fees are charged per vehicle at individual sites. All campgrounds listed, with the exception of "non-fee" sites, are managed by Outdoors in Plumas and fee information can be found at www.outdoorsinplumas.com

Deanes Valley Campground / Elev. 4,400'

Located 4 miles SW of Quincy off of Bucks Lake Rd. in the Meadow Valley area. Take the Slate Creek/Deanes Valley Rd. turn off from Bucks Lake Rd.

- 7 units

- vault toilet

Silver Lake Campground / Elev. 5,800'



Off Bucks Lake Rd. 16 miles west of Quincy. Take the 24N29X Road off of Bucks Lake Rd.; 6 miles to the campground. Campground has trail access to the Bucks Lake Wilderness.

- 9 units

Snake Lake Campground / Elev. 5,800'



Off Bucks Lake Road 8 miles northwest of Quincy. Take County Road 422, 3 miles off of Bucks Lake Road to the Campground.

- 17 sites; 8 equestrian sites w/corrals, no hookups
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- horses only allowed in equestrian sites

Meadow Camp Campground

Located approximately 10 miles west of Quincy, off of Forest Service Rd. 24N29. Streamside campsites. Both RV and tent camping.

- 6 units (3 equestrian sites)
- for fees see www.outdoorsinplumas.com
- vault toilet
- no water

Mt. Hough Non-Fee Campgrounds

The following campgrounds are "self-service" and no fees are charged. All have vault toilets and no piped water.

Brady's Camp Campground / Elev. 7,200'

Off Hwy. 70, 6 miles east of Quincy. Take Squirrel Creek turnoff, go 8 miles toward Argentine Lookout.

- 6 units
- no fee
- vault toilet, bear boxes

Red Bridge Camp Campground / Elev. 3,900'

Travelling east from Quincy on Hwy 70, turn south on La Porte Rd. – about 7 miles

- 5 units
- no fee
- vault toilet
