OSV - Over-snow vehicle that is defined as a motor vehicle that is designed for use over snow and that runs on a track or tracks and/or a ski or skis, while in use over snow.
 NFSR - National Forest System Road that is defined as a forest road other than a road which has been authorized by a legally documented right-of-way held by a State, county or other local public road authority.
 NFST - National Forest System Trail that is defined as a forest trail that is under the jurisdiction of the Forest Service and, in the context of the Travel Management Planning project, allows for use by wheeled motorized vehicles.
