FOREST ORDER NO. 02-21-15 CLEVELAND NATIONAL FOREST HOLY FIRE CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.50 (b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Trabuco Ranger District of the Cleveland National Forest. This Order is effective from October 20, 2021 until October 19, 2022.

- 1. Being on any of the National Forest System trails listed below, as shown on the attached map. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).
 - a. Holy Jim Trail (Forest Trail No. 6W03), between Holy Jim Falls and North Main Divide Road (Forest Road No. 3S04)
 - b. West Horsethief Trail (Forest Trail No. 6W11)
 - c. Trabuco Trail (Forest Trail No. 6W04)

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order) specifically exempting them from this Order.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
