

# FOREST ORDER

## Camping and Fire Restrictions

Order No. 93-04-04

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on lands administered by the Chugach National Forest as described below. These restrictions are in addition to those stated in Sub-part A, Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261, and become effective immediately, and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

Within 1/4 mile of the Sterling Hiway (Alaska State #1), from milepost 50.5, west to milepost 55.

Within 1/4 mile of the Russian River campground and entrance road.



1. 36 CFR 261.52 (a) Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, except in places designated and provided for such use.
2. 36 CFR 261.58 (e) Camping, except in designated areas.
3. 36 CFR 261.58 (r) Launching a boat except at a designated launching area.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

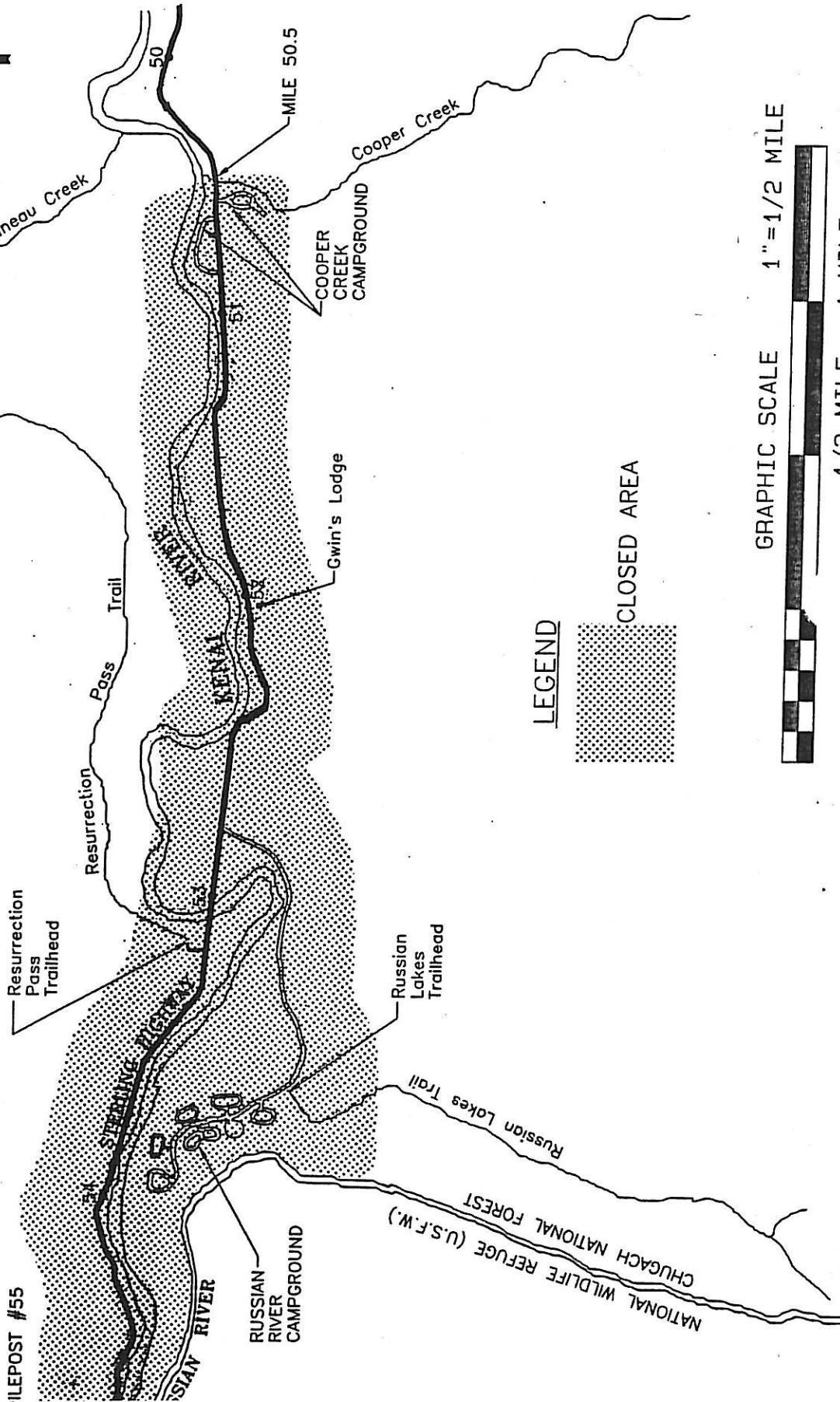
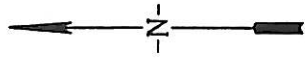
