LA GARITA WILDERNESS

GRAND MESA, UNCOMPAHGRE, GUNNISON AND RIO GRANDE NATIONAL FORESTS

The following acts are *prohibited* on National Forest System land within the **LA GARITA WILDERNESS** of the Grand Mesa, Uncompanyere, Gunnison and Rio Grande National Forests.

- 1. Entering or being in the restricted area with more than 15 people per group, with a maximum combination group size not to exceed 25 people and/or stock. 36 CFR 261.58 (f)
- 2. Camping:
 - a) within one hundred feet of any lake, stream, National Forest System Trail, or any "No Camping" or "Wilderness Restoration Site" sign.
 - b) within 300 feet of Machin Lake.
 - c) within the Wheeler Geologic Area except at designated sites. 36 CFR 261.58 (e)
- **3.** Building, maintaining or using a campfire:
 - a) within one hundred (100) feet of any lake or stream.
 - b) above treeline.
 - c) within 300 feet of Machin lake.
 - d) within the Wheeler Geologic Area. 36 CFR 261.52 (a)
- 4. Storing equipment, personal property, or supplies for longer than seven (7) days. 36 CFR 261.57 (f)
- 5. Confining any pack or saddle animal:
 - a) within one hundred (100) feet of any lake, stream, or National Forest System Trail.
 - b) within 300 feet of Machin Lake. 36 CFR 261.58 (aa)
 - Note: the term "confining" is defined as picketing, highlining, hitching, tethering or corraling.
- 6. Possessing a dog which is not under control, or which is disturbing or damaging wildlife, people, or property.
 <u>Note</u>: the term "under control" is defined as the dog being leashed, and/or under direct verbal control by the dogs' owner or handler at all times. 36 CFR 261.58 (s)
- 7. Shortcutting a switchback in a trail. 36 CFR 261.55 (e)
