

OCCUPANCY AND USE

Dakota Prairie National Grasslands

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) the following acts are prohibited on the areas described in this order, within the Dakota Prairie National Grasslands.

1. A person is prohibited from camping or otherwise occupying a site for more than fourteen (14) consecutive days. (36 CFR 261.58 (a))
2. A person who has occupied a site for the limit listed above is prohibited from reoccupying that site or occupying a second site within five (5) road miles of the original site before (5) days have elapsed. (36 CFR 261.58 (a))


AFFECTED AREA: This order applies to all areas on National Forest System lands within the boundaries of the Dakota Prairie National Grasslands.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons operating under cooperative agreement, memorandum of understanding, special use permit, volunteer agreement or operating plan that stipulates other conditions of occupancy.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
