FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS

Dakota Prairie National Grasslands

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on Forest Development Trail 8002 (Long X) and Forest Development Trail 8003 (Summit) as shown on the attached map.

- 1. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order. For the purpose of this order, this restriction applies to motorized vehicles on Forest Development Trail 8002 (Long X) for the entire length of the trail from its origin in Section 17, Township 147 North, Range 99 West, to its terminus in Section 3, Township 147 North, Range 99 West. (36 CFR 261.55(b))
- 2. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order. For the purpose of this order, this restriction applies to motorized vehicles on Forest Development Trail 8003 (Summit) for the entire length of the trail from its origin in Section 10, Township 147 North, Range 99 West, to its terminus in Section 24, Township 147 North, Range 99 West. (36 CFR 261.55(b))

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act of omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.




Attachment A Motorized Vehicle Closures Summit and Long X Trail T147N R99W
