How to Enable Excel Macro Settings

- 1. In Excel 2010, left mouse click the "File" Menu heading near the upper Left corner of the Excel Window which will take you to the Excel backstage.
- 2. On the Left frame of the Excel backstage, left mouse click Options (just above Exit) which will open a new Excel Options window.
- 3. On the Left frame of the Excel Options window, left mouse click "Trust Center" (at the bottom of the left frame), which will change the Excel Options window contents.
- 4. Then Left mouse click "Trust Center Settings..." found on the right, centered, which will open a new Trust Center window.
- 5. On the left frame of the Trust Center Window, left mouse click "Macro Settings".
- 6. Then left mouse click the round button to "Enable all macros (not recommended; potentially dangerous code can run)" at the bottom of the upper Macro Setting list.
- 7. Click "OK" in the lower right corner to close the Trust Center window.
- 8. Click "OK" in the lower right corner to close the Excel Options window.
- 9. Exit Excel 2010 without saving.
- 10. Restart Excel to be able to use Excel Macro-Enabled Workbooks.
