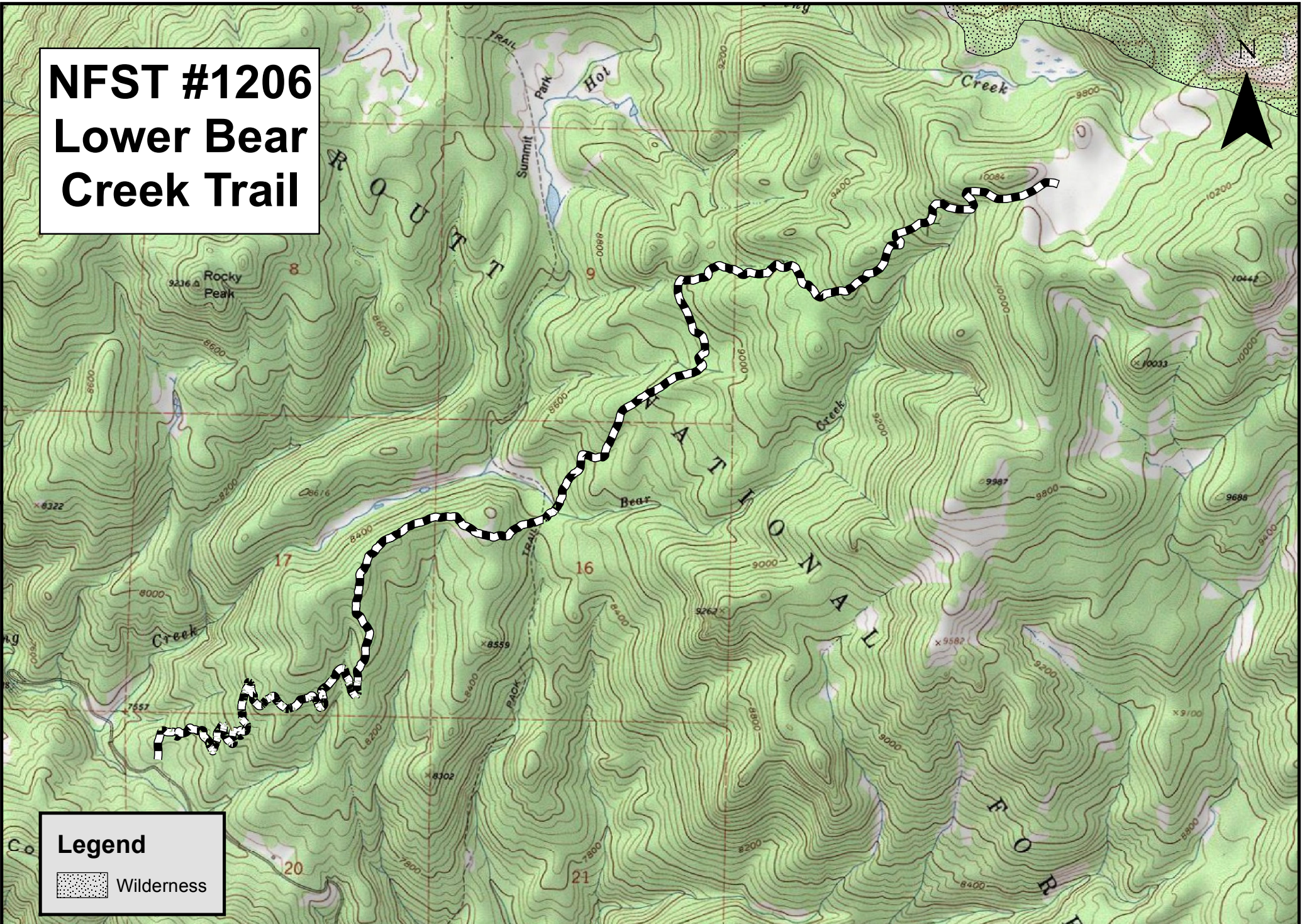
	<u>TRAIL NAME:</u> #1206 BEAR CREEK / LOWER BEAR	
<u>TRAIL BEGINNING:</u> 8400' elevation (2560m)	<u>LENGTH:</u> 2.7 mi (4.3km)	
<u>TRAIL ENDING:</u> 10000' elevation (3048m)	<u>RECOMMENDED SEASON:</u> Spring Summer Fall	
<u>ACCESS #1:</u> From Lincoln Avenue, turn northeast on Third Street. Turn right at the first stop sign onto Fish Creek Falls Road. Take the first left, Amethyst, and follow it to the end, Strawberry Park Road. Turn right and go 4 miles to the TH sign on the right. This road is rough. You can park here.	<u>USE:</u> Moderate	<u>DIFFICULTY:</u> More Difficult
<u>NARRATIVE:</u> From the TH it is a fairly steep uphill climb through scrub oak and aspen on single track trail until you get to NFSR 314. The trail makes a short left jog across the creek, and then another jog to the right. It eventually turns to single track and is a more heavily wooded spruce, fir forest. After 2.7 miles of climbing the trail dead ends at Summit Park.
