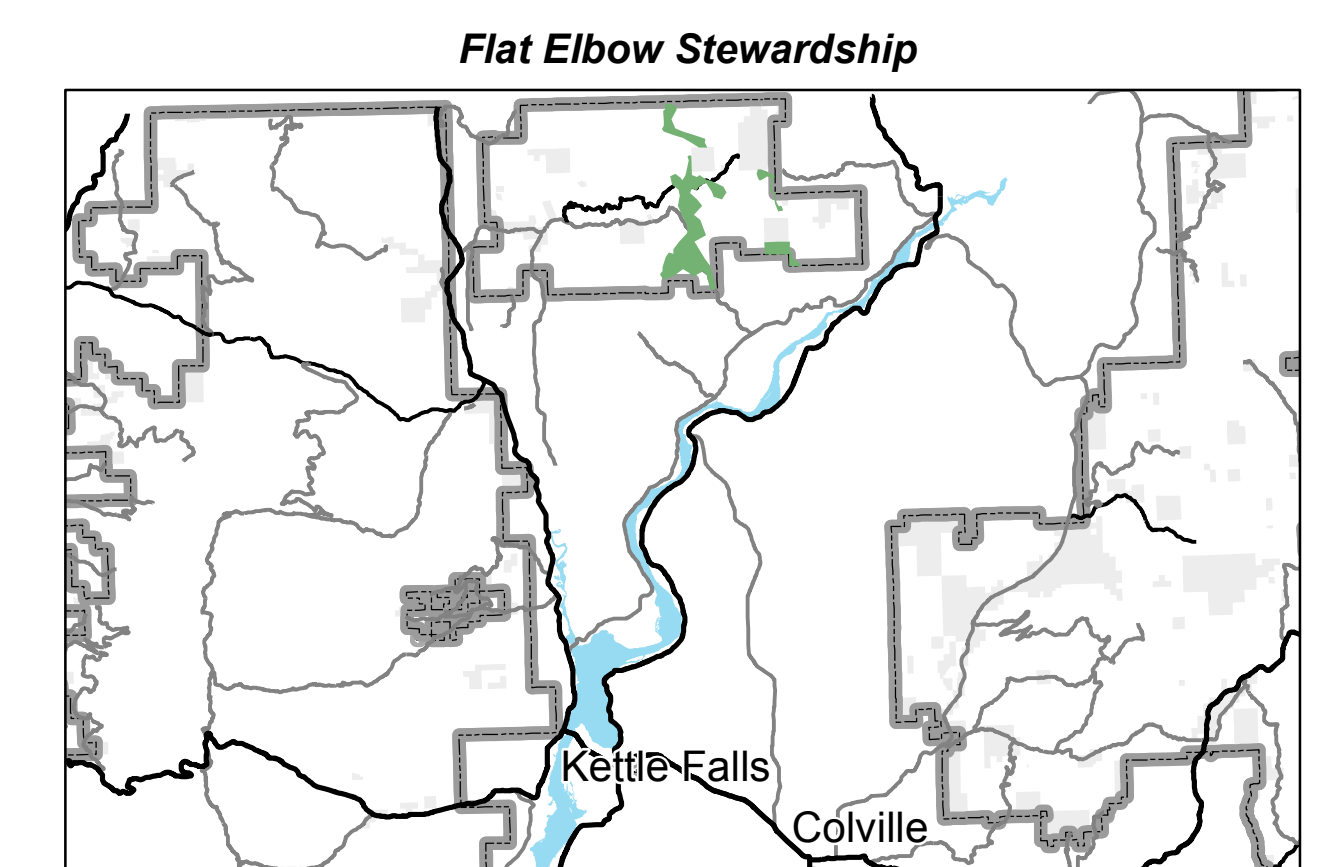

For subdivisions that have a road as a boundary (as shown on this map), the official boundary for the section that isn't painted is the edge of the road on the unit side.

Protection of Improvements Not Owned by Forest Service: There may be mining claim monuments within and adjacent to subdivisions. If discovered, every effort should be made to protect these monuments. Legal claims meet the following general description: there should be 5 monuments per claim. They are located at the point of discovery of the valuable mineral deposit, and at each of the corners of the claim. Lode claims extend 600 feet on either side of the point of discovery, and are 1500 feet long. Each claim corner is staked, and a mound of rocks is usually piled around the post. Posts are typically white PVC pipe, though you still may see white oak/hardwood posts, or even T-posts. Each corner should be signed with the name of the claim and the claim number. Claims often lie side by side or end to end - so two claims may share monument posts. Each lode-type mining claim is approx. 20 acres in size. G.2.2.1
