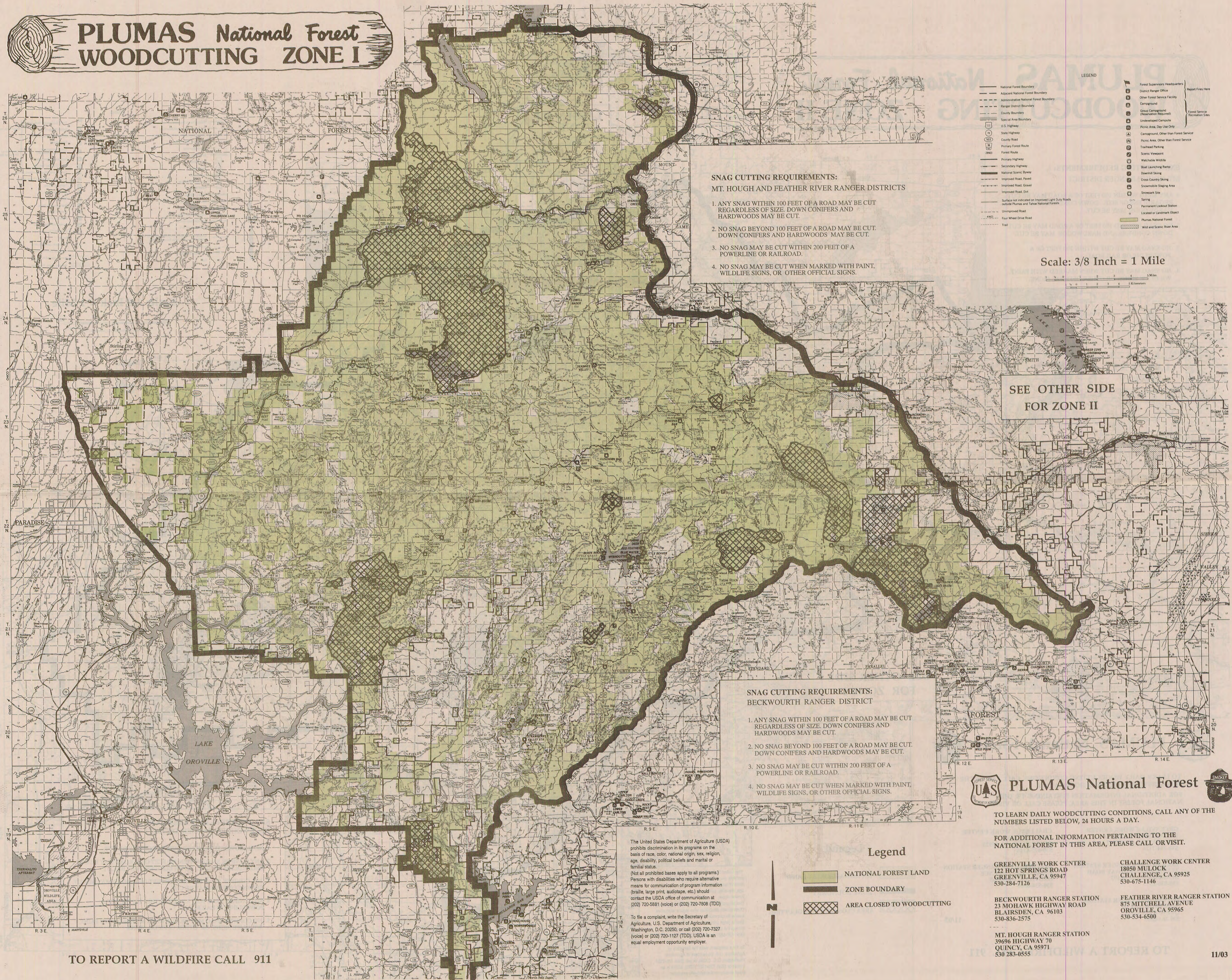


PLUMAS National Forest WOODCUTTING ZONE I



SNAG CUTTING REQUIREMENTS: MT. HOUGH AND FEATHER RIVER RANGER DISTRICTS

1. ANY SNAG WITHIN 100 FEET OF A ROAD MAY BE CUT REGARDLESS OF SIZE. DOWN CONIFERS AND HARDWOODS MAY BE CUT.
2. NO SNAG BEYOND 100 FEET OF A ROAD MAY BE CUT. DOWN CONIFERS AND HARDWOODS MAY BE CUT.
3. NO SNAG MAY BE CUT WITHIN 200 FEET OF A POWERLINE OR RAILROAD.
4. NO SNAG MAY BE CUT WHEN MARKED WITH PAINT, WILDLIFE SIGNS, OR OTHER OFFICIAL SIGNS.

SNAG CUTTING REQUIREMENTS: BECKWOURTH RANGER DISTRICT

1. ANY SNAG WITHIN 100 FEET OF A ROAD MAY BE CUT REGARDLESS OF SIZE. DOWN CONIFERS AND HARDWOODS MAY BE CUT.
2. NO SNAG BEYOND 100 FEET OF A ROAD MAY BE CUT. DOWN CONIFERS AND HARDWOODS MAY BE CUT.
3. NO SNAG MAY BE CUT WITHIN 200 FEET OF A POWERLINE OR RAILROAD.
4. NO SNAG MAY BE CUT WHEN MARKED WITH PAINT, WILDLIFE SIGNS, OR OTHER OFFICIAL SIGNS.

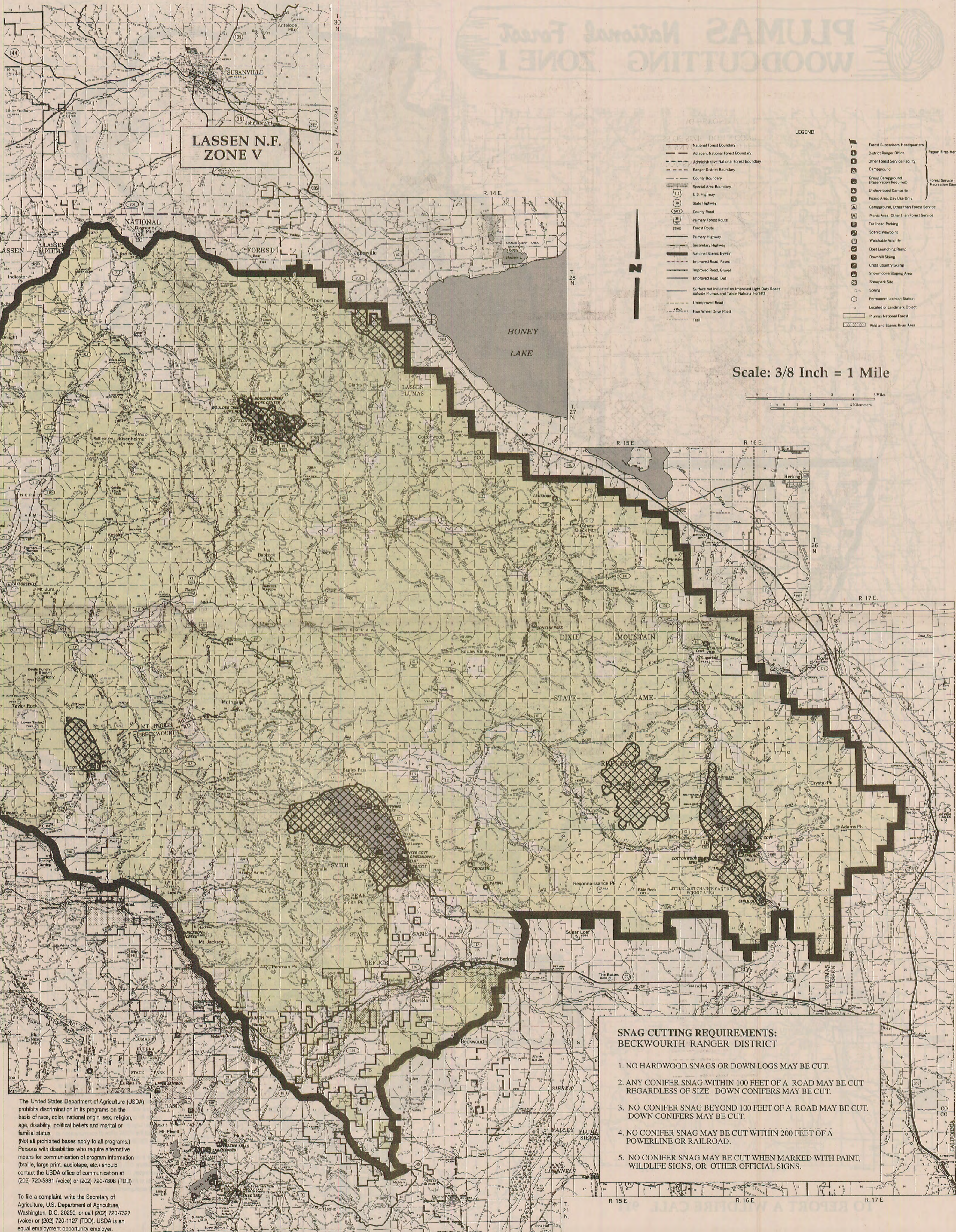

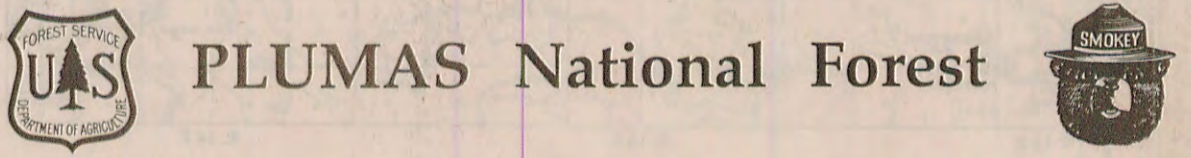

1. NO HARDWOOD SNAGS OR DOWN LOGS MAY BE CUT.
2. ANY CONIFER SNAG WITHIN 100 FEET OF A ROAD MAY BE CUT REGARDLESS OF SIZE. DOWN CONIFERS MAY BE CUT.
3. NO CONIFER SNAG BEYOND 100 FEET OF A ROAD MAY BE CUT. DOWN CONIFERS MAY BE CUT.
4. NO CONIFER SNAG MAY BE CUT WITHIN 200 FEET OF A POWERLINE OR RAILROAD.
5. NO CONIFER SNAG MAY BE CUT WHEN MARKED WITH PAINT, WILDLIFE SIGNS, OR OTHER OFFICIAL SIGNS.
