**Militia Company To
Fight Forest Fires**

Governor Norris received a request Wednesday from Libby to excuse Company L of the Montana national guard from going to the grand encampment at American Lake, the representation being made that the men were needed to fight the forest fires in the vicinity of that town. The governor sent the following reply:

"Have directed the adjutant general to keep in touch with the situation in the vicinity of Libby, and if it seems advisable for Company L not to be moved to the encampment, the excuse will be granted."

Governor Norris has advised the district forester of his action and if the word comes from Libby that the services of the members of Company L are really needed there they will not be required to attend the encampment.
