

ORDER

USE OF VEHICLES OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS

ROOSEVELT NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) & (b), the following acts are prohibited within the North Weber Area, Roosevelt National Forest:

1. Possessing or using a motorized vehicle, off Forest Development roads from September 15 to December 1 annually, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.56
2. Using motorized vehicles in the area south of South Lone Pine Creek in the S 1/2, Section 35, T. 10 N., R. 73 W., 6th P.M., as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54 (a).

Pursuant to 35 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Registered snowmobiles and other over-the-snow vehicles operating on snow and where not otherwise prohibited are exempt from this order.
