

ORDER

FIRE, OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS

ARAPAHO AND ROOSEVELT NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited within the LOST LAKE (located 62 miles northwest of Fort Collins, off Colorado Highway 14), LARAMIE LAKE & TWIN LAKES areas of the Roosevelt National Forest, until further notice:

I CAMPING

Camping within 100 feet of the shores of Lost Lake, Laramie Lake & Twin Lakes as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.58 (e).

II FIRES

Building, maintaining, attending, or using an open fire or campfire within 100 feet of the shores of Lost Lake, Laramie Lake & Twin Lakes as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52 (a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
