TRAILHEADS SIERRA ANCHA WILDERNESS

Not uncommonly one of the more challenging parts of a backcountry trip is attempting to find the trailhead itself. To assist you in reaching the jumping-off place, we have developed the following directions to the trailhead named below:

Oak Creek - From Claypool (between Miami and Globe), take State Highway 88 northwest for approximately 15 miles to its junction with State Highway 288. Turn right onto Highway 288 and drive north for approximately 15 miles to Forest Road 189. A high-clearance or 4WD vehicle is recommended beyond this point. Take Road 189 east for 5 miles to the trailhead at the Oak Creek Cabin (Please do not disturb the range facilities located here). Trail accessed: Coon Creek Trail 254, Coon Spring Trail 124.

Be sure to secure your vehicle, and don't leave valuables in sight while your gone. Also be sure someone knows where you are going.
