

# TRAILHEADS

## SIERRA ANCHA WILDERNESS

Not uncommonly one of the more challenging parts of a backcountry trip is attempting to find the trailhead itself. To assist you in reaching the jumping-off place, we have developed the following directions to the trailhead named below:

**Bull Canyon** - From Claypool (between Miami and Globe), take State Highway 88 northwest for approximately 15 miles to its junction with State Highway 288. Turn right onto Highway 288 and drive north for approximately 6.6 miles to the cherry Creek Road (Forest Road 203). Take road 203 east for nine miles, then turn north on Forest Road 203A. Follow this road for approximately 6.5 miles to the trailhead. A high-clearance or 4WD vehicle is recommended. Trail accessed: **Deep Creek Trail 128, Coon Spring Trail 124.**

Be sure to secure your vehicle, and don't leave valuables in sight while your gone. Also be sure someone knows where you are going.
