TRAILHEADS SIERRA ANCHA WILDERNESS

Not uncommonly one of the more challenging parts of a backcountry trip is attempting to find the trailhead itself. To assist you in reaching the jumping-off place, we have developed the following directions to the trailhead named below:

Carr TH - From Claypool (between Miami and Globe), take State Highway 88 northwest for approximately 15 miles to its junction with State Highway 288. Turn right onto Highway 288 and drive north for approximately 25.5 miles to Forest Road 487 (just past Workman Creek Bridge). A high-clearance or 4WD vehicle is recommended beyond this point. Take Road 487 east for 4 miles to the trailhead where there is an small parking area on the right side of the road. Note: this road is closed from December 15 through March 30 annually. Trail accessed: Parker Creek Trail 160, Rim Trail 139, and Coon Creek Trail 254.

Be sure to secure your vehicle, and don't leave valuables in sight while you gone. Also be sure someone knows where you are going.
