

ORDER

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS  
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST  
ASPEN RANGER DISTRICT


Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Aspen Ranger District, White River National Forest, until further notice.

1. Entering or being in the water, and the use of any boat (kayak, canoe, raft, etc.) on Maroon Lake as specified on the attached map, 36 CFR 261.58(k).
2. The following are prohibited on the Maroon Creek Road, (FDR 125), as specified on the attached map:
  - a. The parking of any privately owned motorized vehicle in the designated bus parking lots at Maroon Lake from June 19 through Labor Day, annually, 36 CFR 261.58(a).
  - b. Using any motorized vehicle, except for vehicles carrying a minimum of 11 people, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. from June 19 through the end of September, annually, unless sooner rescinded, 36 CFR 261.54(b).
3. Possession of vehicles within Old Snowmass Campground as posted, 36 CFR 261.58(g).
4. Possessing dogs, except for working stock dogs, or dogs used for legal hunting purposes, on the Government Trail, #1980, unless under physical restraint of a leash not to exceed six (6) feet in length, 36 CFR 261.58(s).
5. Using any portion of the Government Trail, #1980, between May 15 - June 20, annually, for wildlife and resource protection, 36 CFR 261.55(a).
6. Camping for more than 14 days in any consecutive 30 day period, 36 CFR 261.58(a).
7. Camping in the locations specified on the attached maps except in developed campgrounds and designated camping locations, 36 CFR 261.58(e).
8. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire outside of a metal firering, stove, grill, or fireplace provided by the Forest Service, (except self-contained personal stoves) in the areas specified on the attached maps, 36 CFR 261.52(a).

The following persons are exempt from the prohibition contained in this order: 36 CFR 261.50(e):

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. In addition to the above, the following are exempt from #3 above:
  - a. Vehicles assigned to an overnight camping unit in Silver Bar, Silver Bell, Silver Queen, and Maroon Lake Campgrounds.
  - b. Vehicles carrying horses will be allowed to pass the entrance station to use the East or West Maroon Portal parking lots.
  - c. Vehicles carrying non-ambulatory persons who cannot ride the buses.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine or not more than \$5000 or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both. 16 USC 551

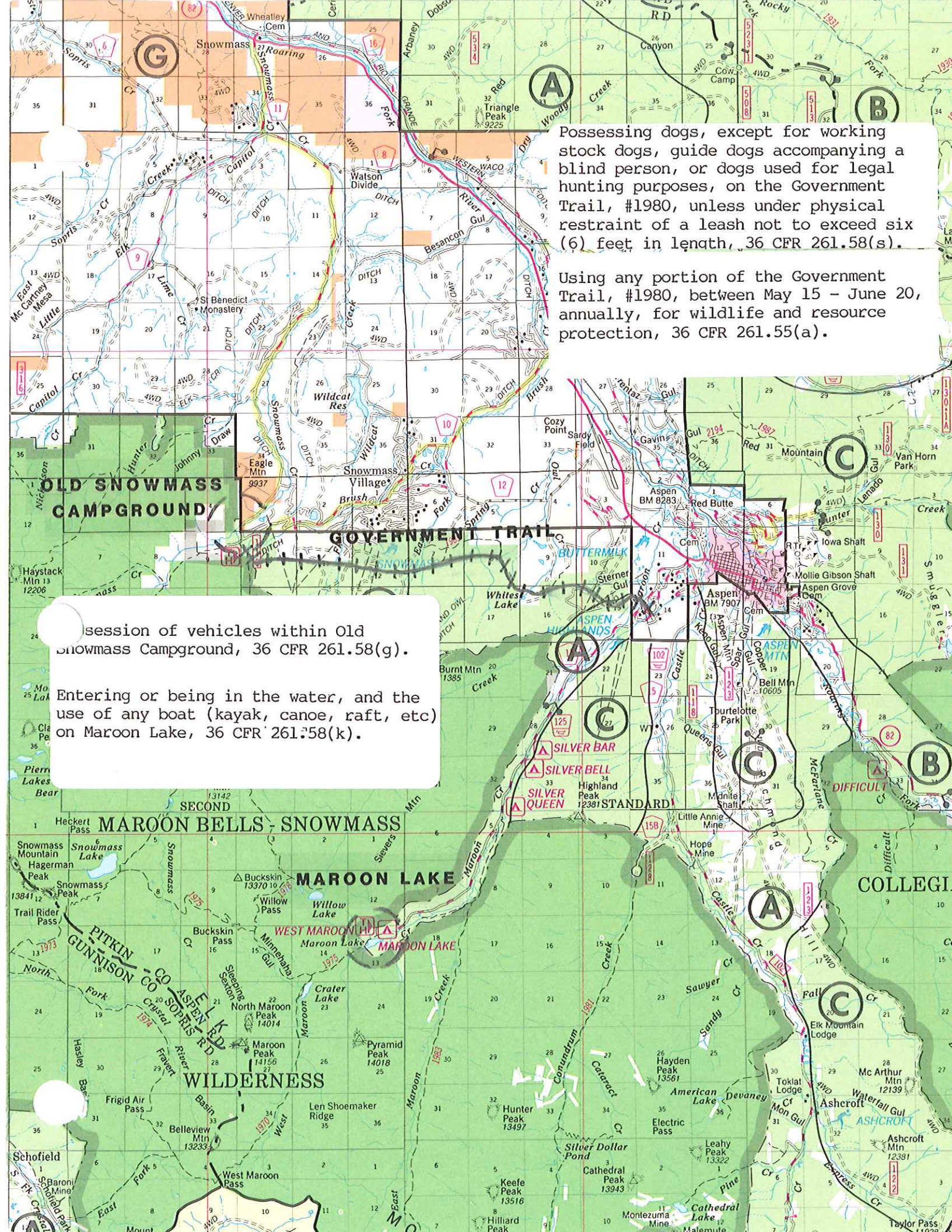


Possessing dogs, except for working stock dogs, guide dogs accompanying a blind person, or dogs used for legal hunting purposes, on the Government Trail, #1980, unless under physical restraint of a leash not to exceed six (6) feet in length, 36 CFR 261.58(s).

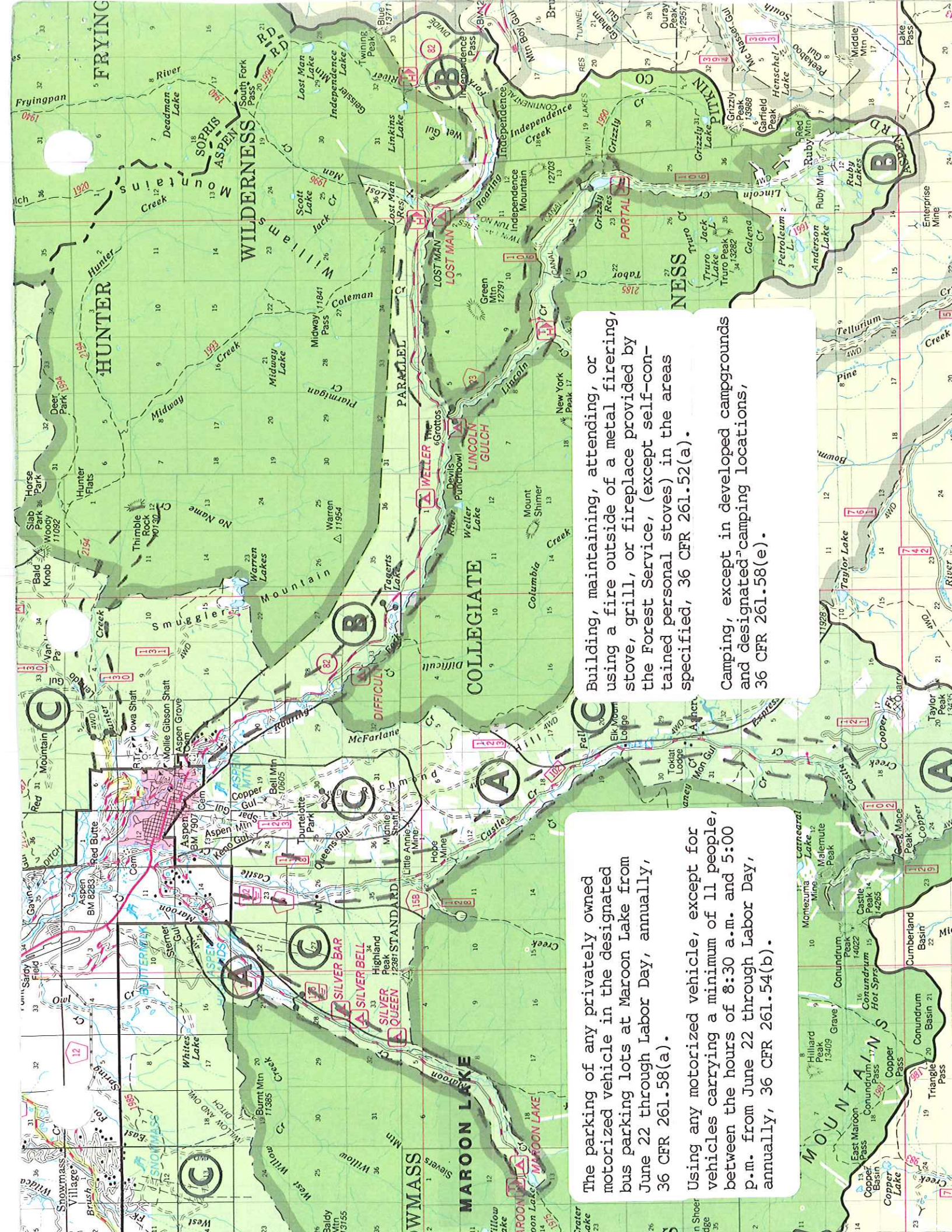
Using any portion of the Government Trail, #1980, between May 15 - June 20, annually, for wildlife and resource protection, 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Prohibition of vehicles within Old Snowmass Campground, 36 CFR 261.58(g).

Prohibition of water activities on Maroon Lake, 36 CFR 261.58(k).







The parking of any privately owned motorized vehicle in the designated bus parking lots at Maroon Lake from June 22 through Labor Day, annually, 36 CFR 261.58(a).

Using any motorized vehicle, except for vehicles carrying a minimum of 11 people, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. from June 22 through Labor Day, annually, 36 CFR 261.54(b).

Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire outside of a metal firing, stove, grill, or fireplace provided by the Forest Service, (except self-contained personal stoves) in the areas specified, 36 CFR 261.52(a).

Camping, except in developed campgrounds and designated camping locations, 36 CFR 261.58(e).
