

ORDER

OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST
BLANCO RANGER DISTRICT


Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Blanco Ranger District, White River National Forest, until further notice.

1. To hitch, tether, hobble, or leave in a corral or other enclosure a horse or other pack or saddle animal within 50 feet of the Morapos Trailhead or Road FDR 253 for more than 15 minutes, 36 CFR 261.58(aa).
2. Camping in the locations specified on the attached maps except in developed campgrounds and designated camping locations, 36 CFR 261.58(e).

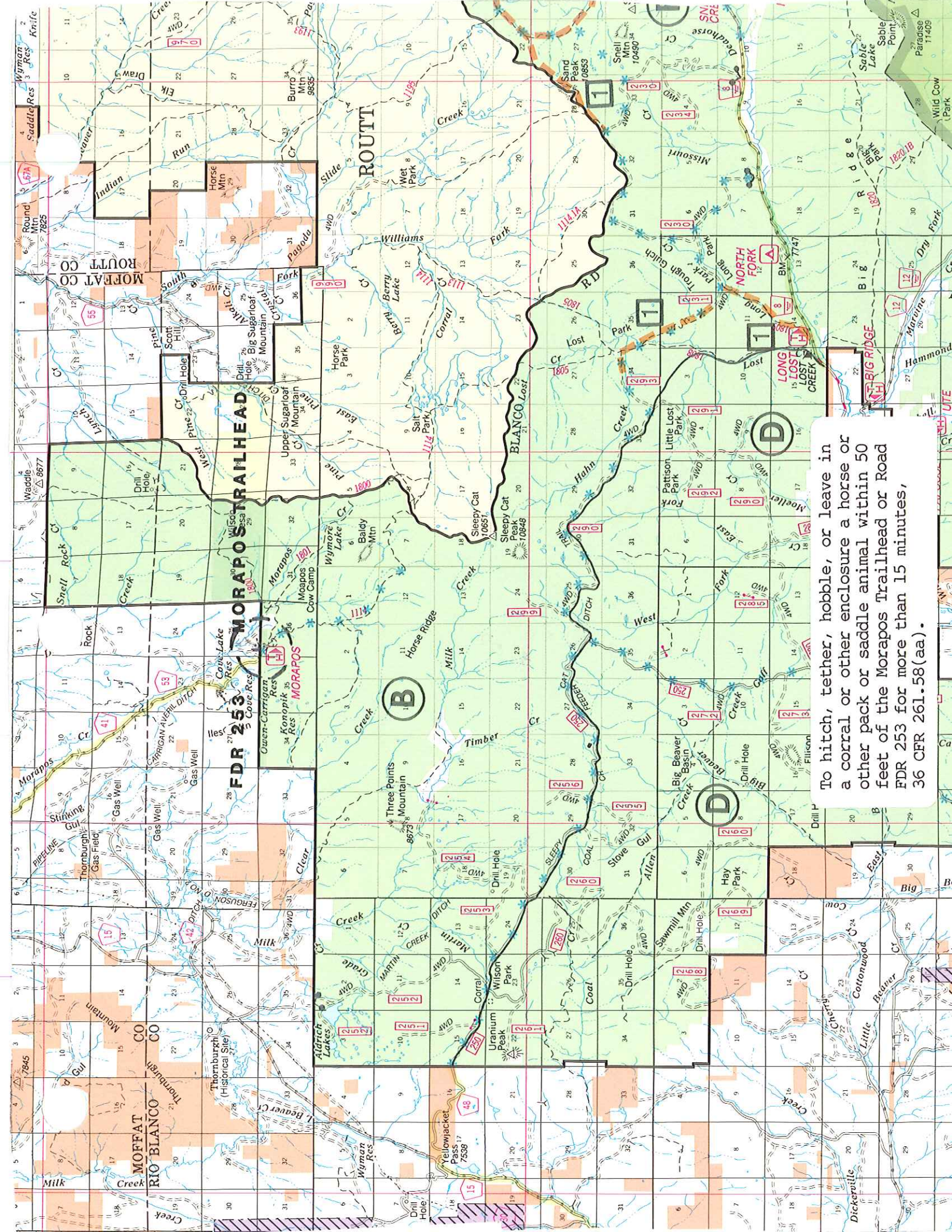
The following persons are exempt from the prohibition contained in this order, 36 CFR 261.50(e):

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both. 16 USC 551
