

PERMANENT ROAD CLOSURE

87-7



Pursuant to Title 16 U. S. C. 551 and 559 and Title CFR 2612.50, the following regulations are established within the boundaries of the Arapaho National Forest as shown on the accompanying map.

The following roads on the Dillon District of the Arapaho National Forest will be closed yearlong to the use of motorized vehicles (36 CFR 261.53(b)). This closure is necessary to (1) comply with Forest Management plans; (2) provide seclusion for wildlife; (3) maintain a natural appearing environment.

Harrigan Creek Road FDR No. 292
Bordoux Gulch Road FDR No. 293
Harrigan Spur Road FDR no. 294

Situated approximately 1 mile NW of the Blue River Campground in T3S, R78W, Section 32 and T4S, R78W Section 5. The above mentioned roads proceed north from the Boulder Creek Road (FDR 205) towards Bordoux Gulch and Harrigan Creek.

Grove Road FDR No. 240.1B
Upper Cabin Road FDR No. FDR 240.1C


Situated approximately 1 mile west of the Gold Hill Subdivision in T6S, R78W, Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13 and 14. The above mentioned roads proceed west from Gold Hill Subdivisions towards Gold Hill and Ophir Mountains.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.53(b) each of the following is exempt from this act:

1. Persons with permits specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local official, and/or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

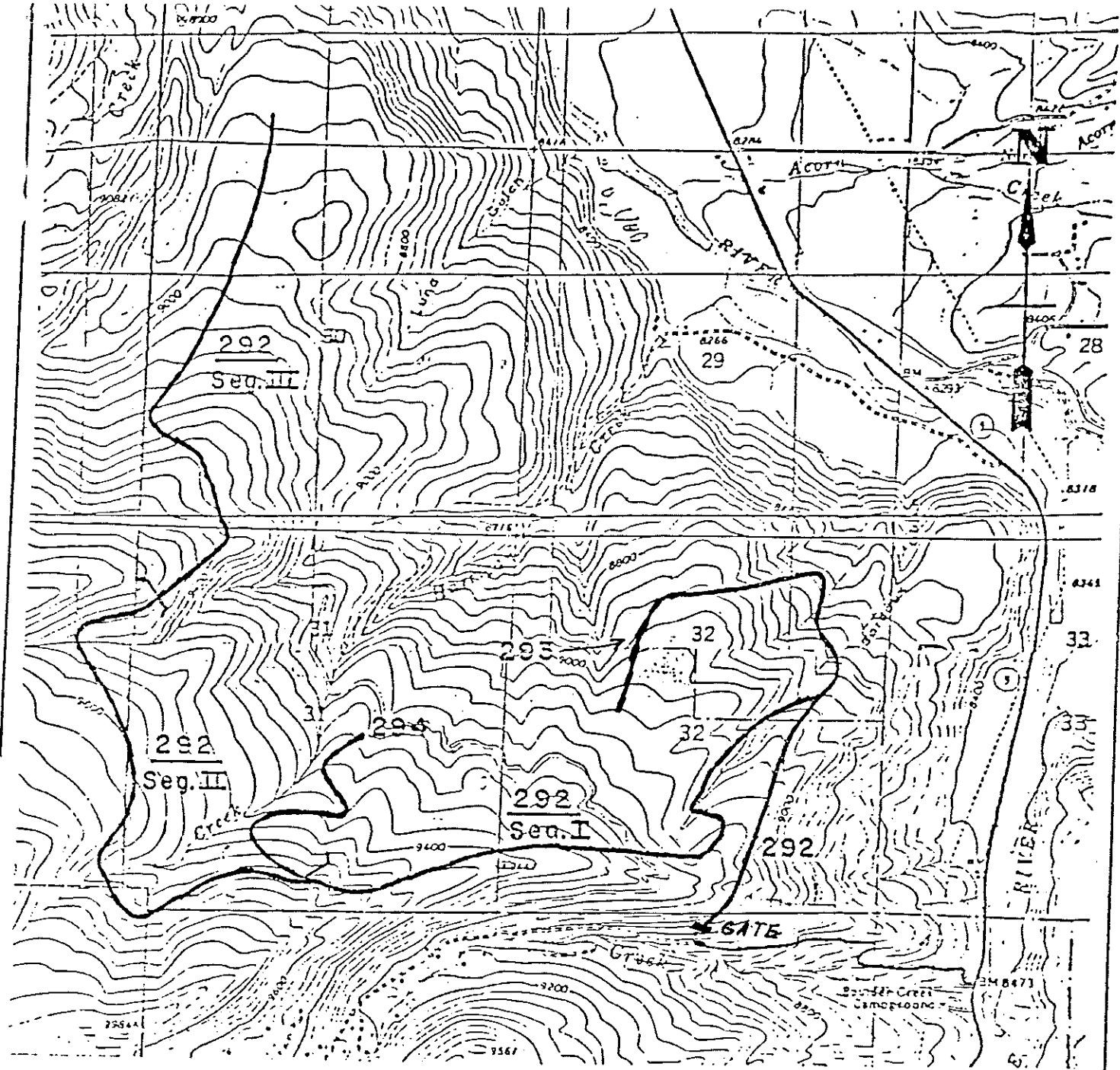

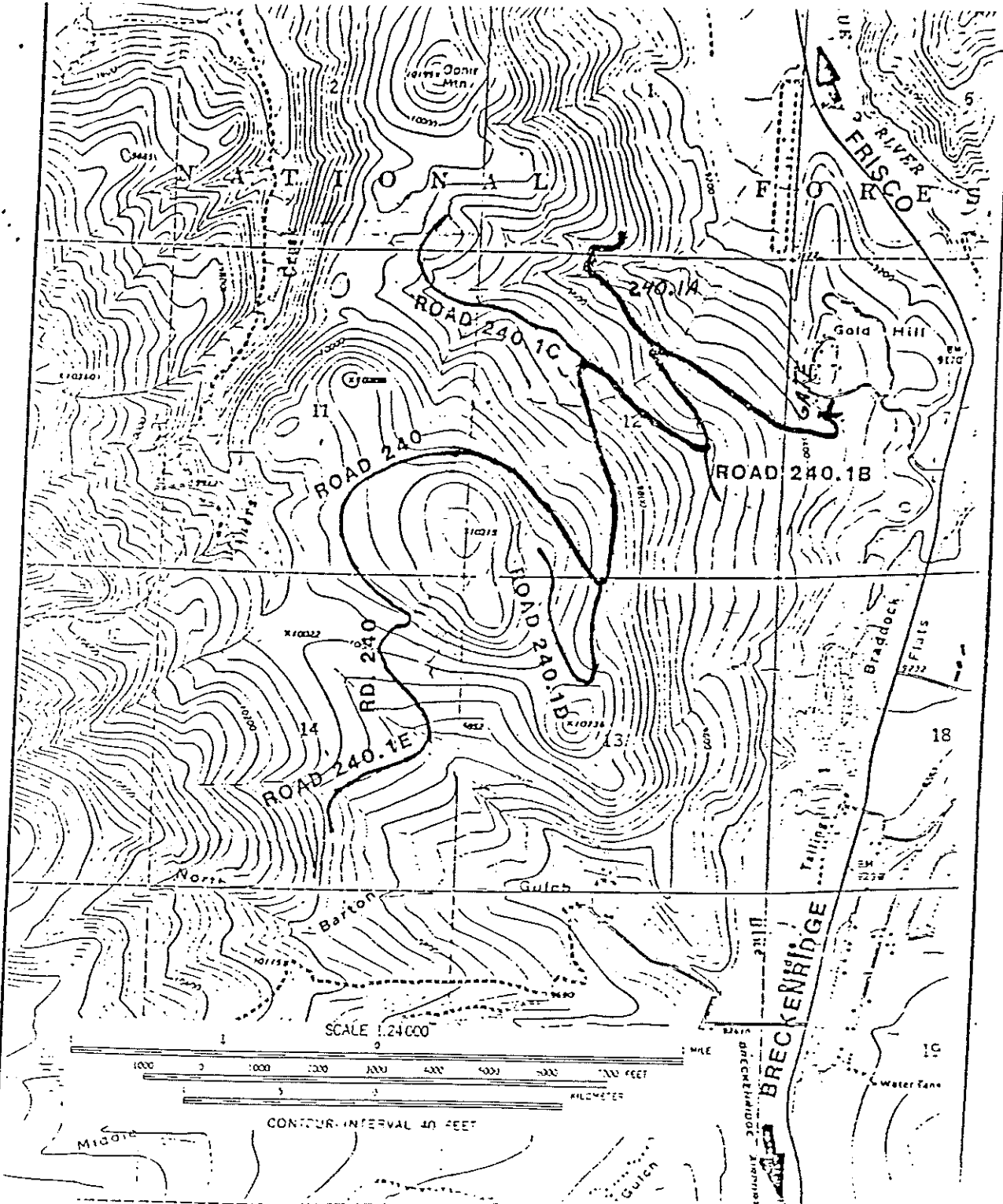
