

## ORDER

OCCUPANCY AND USE REGULATIONS

ARAPAHO NATIONAL FOREST  
(Administered by The WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited, commencing November 15 and ending on July 5 annually, for the protection of public health and safety until further notice.

- (1) It is prohibited to enter or be upon any area which is closed. See description of closed areas below. 36 CFR 261.53 (e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or Local officer or member of an organized rescue, in the performance of official duty.

The areas of closure are described by the following:

The areas closed are adjacent to the Arapahoe Basin Ski Area Boundary and are 15 feet in width.

Closure: From the 11,000 foot level of the ski area permit boundary directly west of the Fourth Alley, running along the ski area permit boundary to the top of the ski area and then east and north along the permit boundary across the top of Lenawee Mountain (East Wall), northwest down the ridge separating East Wall from Marjorie Basin and continuing along the ski area permit boundary to U.S. Highway 6. (T5S, R76W, Sec. 2,3,10 and 11). See exhibit A attached.
