

ORDER
USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES WITHIN KEYSTONE RESORT

ARAPAHO NATIONAL FOREST (ADMINISTERED BY THE WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST)

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within, and adjacent to, the Keystone Resort permit boundary (as shown on Exhibit A of this order) within the Arapaho National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) Possessing or using any motorized vehicle off Forest Development Roads.
36 CFR 261.56.
- (2) Using any motorized vehicle on Forest Development Road 250 and all intersecting spur roads.
36 CFR 261.54(a).
- (3) Using any motorized vehicle on Forest Development Road 175 (Keystone Gulch road), from November 1 until July 1 annually.
36 CFR 261.54(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

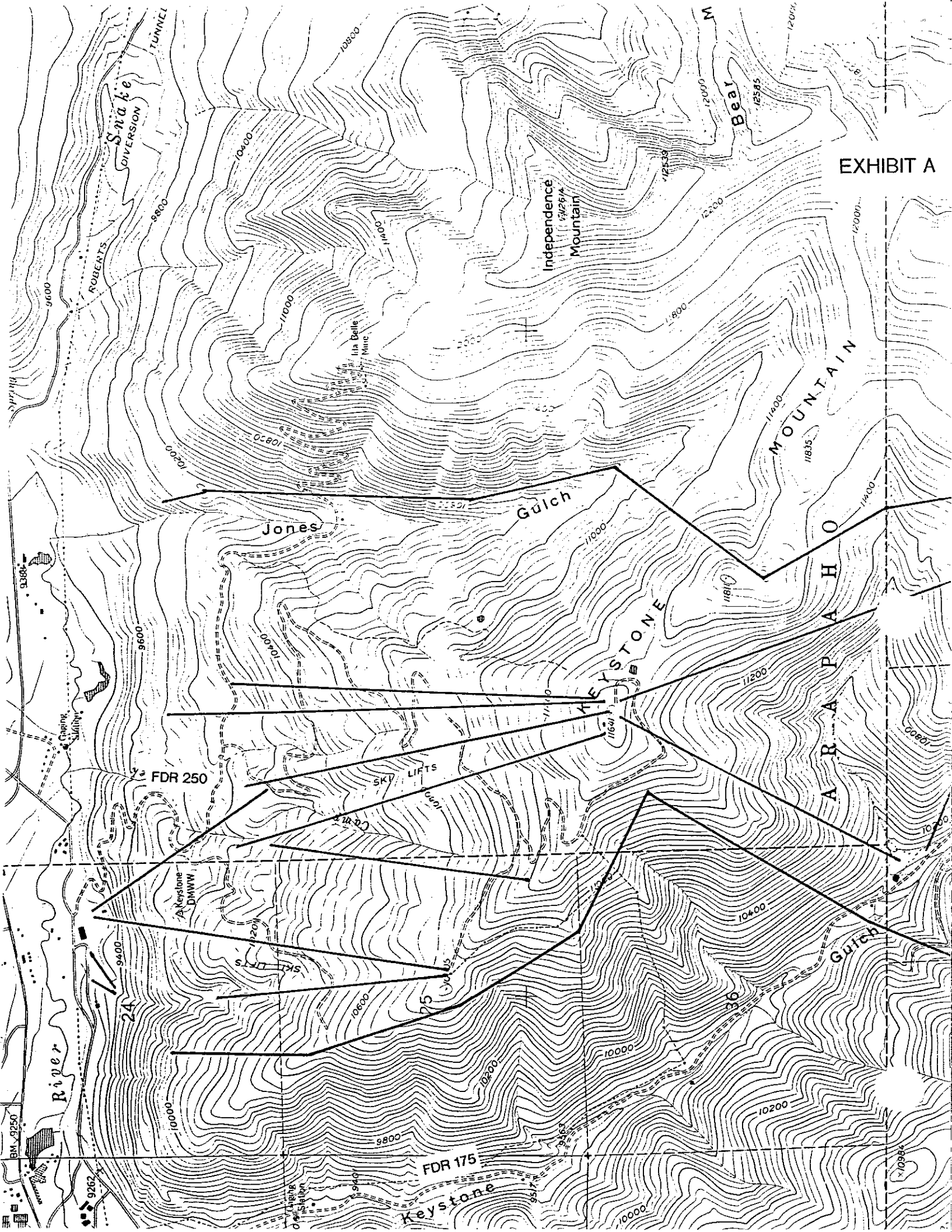

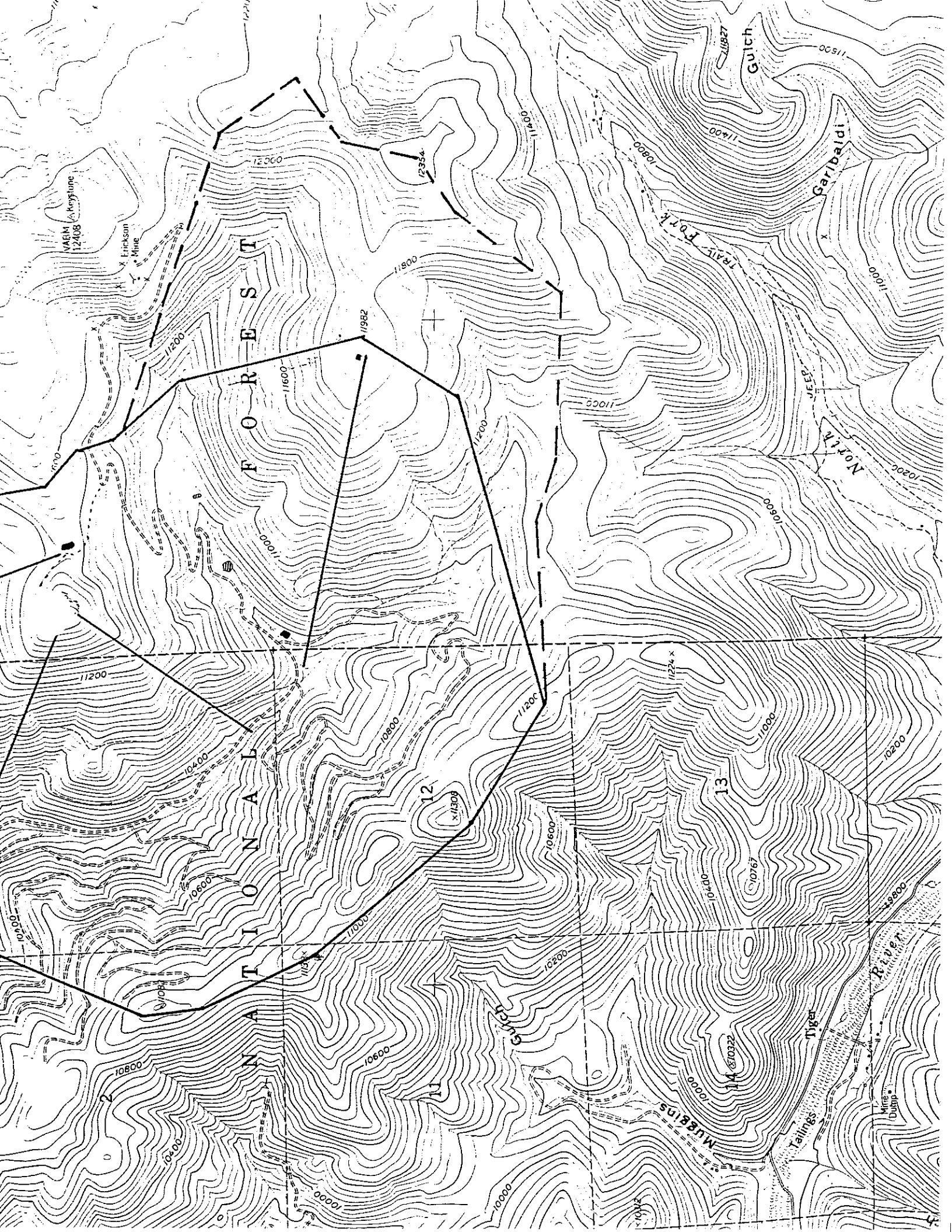
