

ORDER

USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES OFF ROADS

DILLON RANGER DISTRICT
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a), the following act is prohibited, at the area surrounding the Boreas Pass Section House, (as shown on Exhibit A), within the White River National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) Possessing or using any motorized vehicle, including snowmobiles, off Forest Development Road 10, Boreas Pass Road.
36 CFR 261.56.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

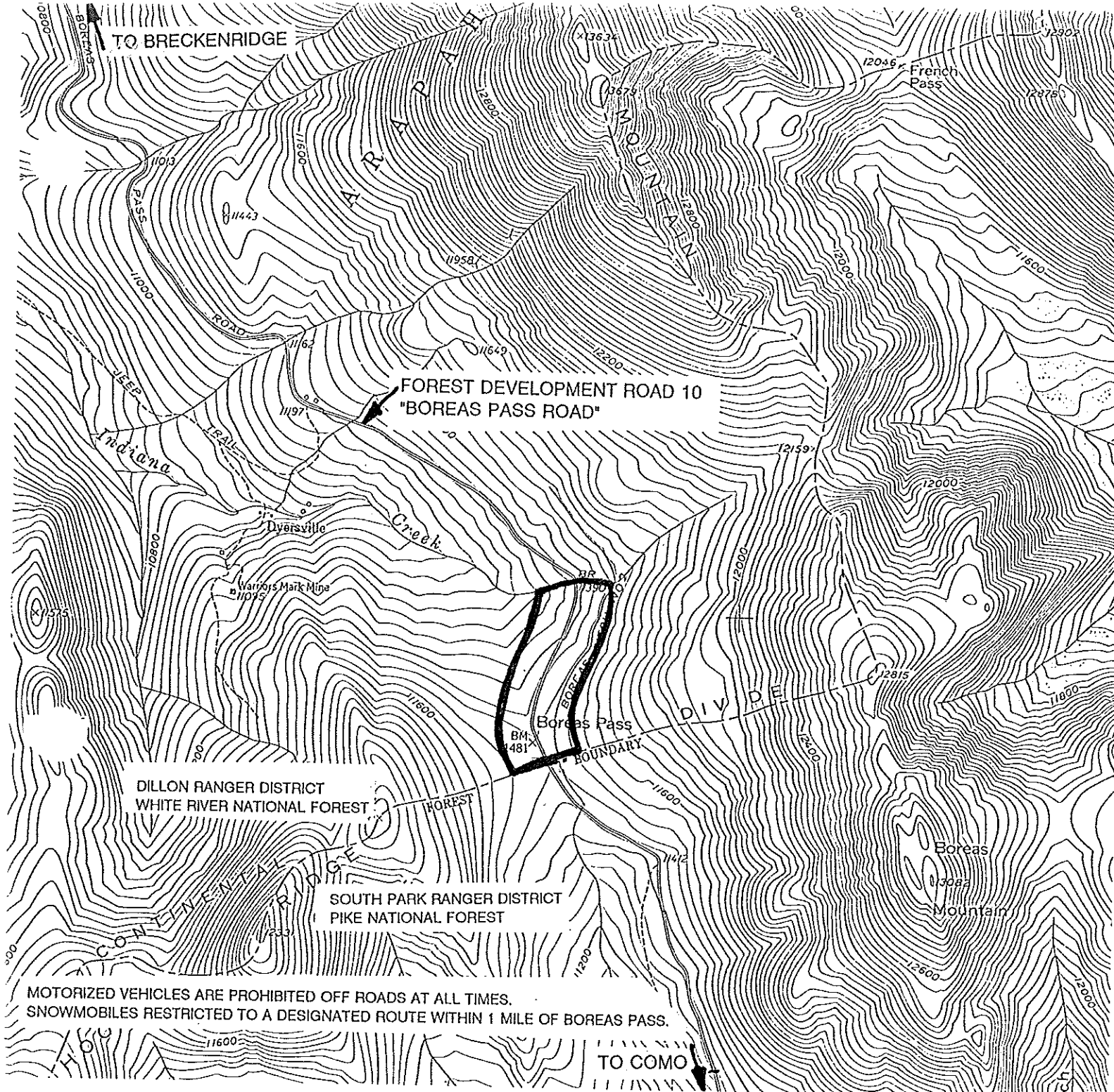
