

ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST
DILLON RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within the boundaries of the Dillon Ranger District, White River National Forest, until this Order is rescinded.

1. Storing or leaving a boat in the location specified on the attached map is prohibited (Dillon Reservoir), except in direct association with camping use at Pine Cove Campground and designated campsites at Heaton Bay and Peak One Campgrounds, 36 CFR 261.58(p).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the order:

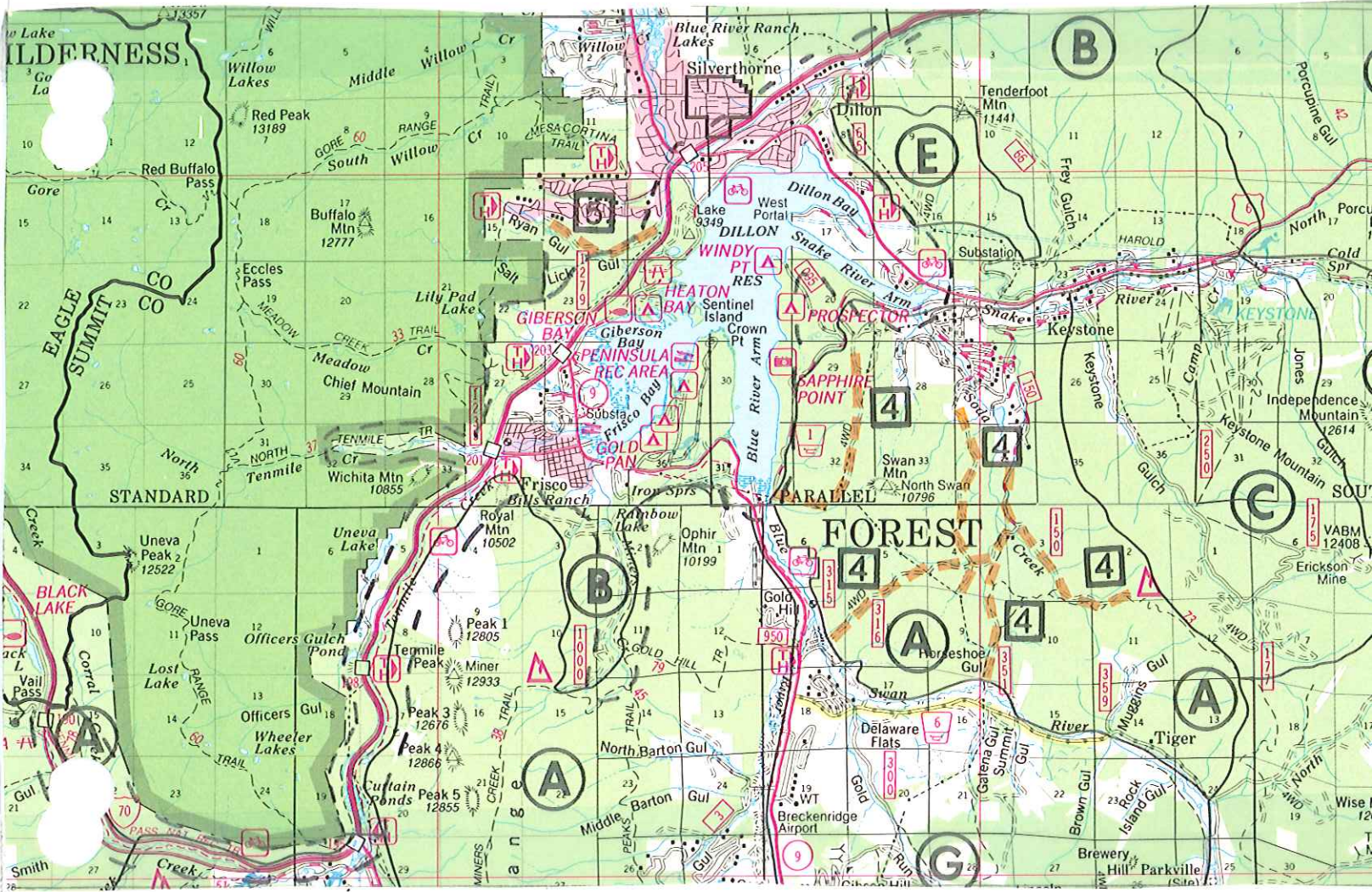
1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
