

SUPERVISOR'S ORDER

OCCUPANCY AND USE REGULATIONS

RIFLE RANGER DISTRICT

WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited in the area described in this order within the White River National Forest, effective October 10, 1990.

Over-snow vehicles operating on snow are permitted throughout the area. Possession or use of other motorized vehicles is prohibited yearlong off of roads and trails and permitted to operate on designated roads and trails. 36 CFR 261.54(a), 261.55(b), and 261.56.

Area of closure is as described by the following:

The area closed is within the Canyon Creek Drainage, from the east side Canyon Creek to the point where intersects FDR 601 and south of FDR 601 along the north side of Carbonate to a point where it intersects with the existing area closure, as shown on the attached map Exhibit A. The area will be identified on the ground by appropriate signing at the points of entry to the closure.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

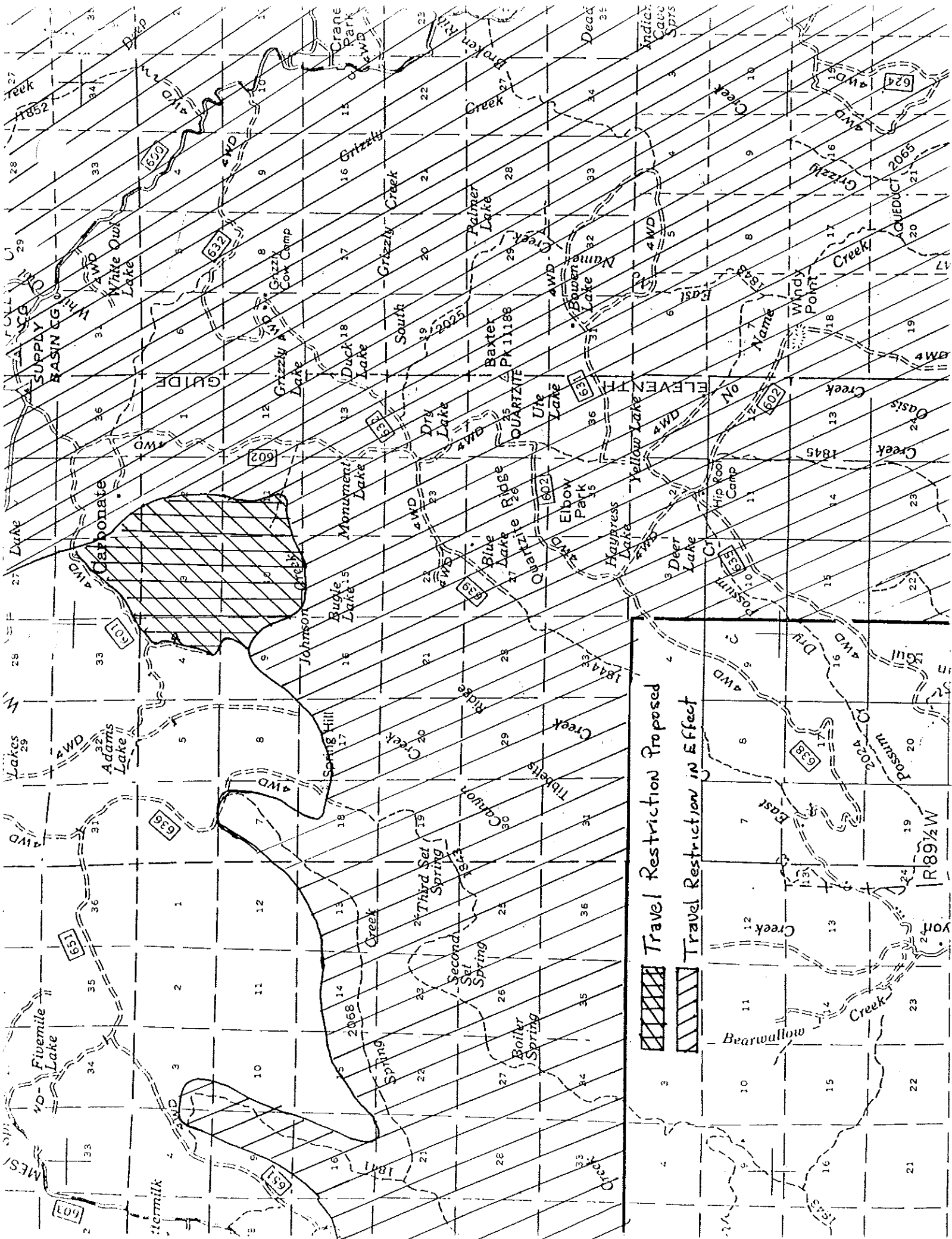
