

ORDERTEMPORARY CLOSURE

## WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following restrictions are imposed within the Sopris Ranger District, White River National Forest, effective immediately and continuing until rescinded. These restrictions are necessary to maintain public safety.


The following acts are prohibited:

- (1) Use of Forest Service Development Roads 307, 3071A, 3071C, 3071D, and 3071E (also known as the Coal Basin Roads) between Mid-Continent Resources property (Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, T10S, R89W) and the upper termini (Sections 5, 8, 17, 21, and 22, T10S, R89W), by motorized vehicles.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Owners of land in the area.
- (2) Persons given written permission by the District Ranger to perform business activities in the Coal Basin area.
- (3) Any Federal, State, or local officers; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
