**‘TYPE 1000 wire’**

These are the required fields **in addition** to the purchaser’s account number and bank information.

\*Note: If paying more than one bill, in Field Tag 6000 list one bill and its related amount, then the next bill and amount, etc....

**Foreign Wire Payment Instructions**

The information is the same as a regular wire payment, other than the foreign bank needs to work through an American bank to convert the money. Once the money is converted into US dollars, then this bank will send the wire payment to the U.S. Treasury.

**NOTE:** Fedwire/Wire payments are not sent to a bank. They are sent directly to Treasury in New York City and are paid through the Cashlink System instead of the Lockbox System. These payments are posted on the CCH Website under Fedwire Payments, and are updated daily.
