

EXPLANATION OF LEGEND ITEMS

Roads Open to Highway Legal Vehicles Only:

These roads are open only to motor vehicles licensed under State law for general operation on all public roads within the State.

Seasonal Designation:

This symbol, used in conjunction with one of the other road or trail symbols, indicates that the road or trail is open only during certain portions of the year. Refer to Seasonal and Special Designation Table for further

Dispersed Camping:

Dispersed Camping, Both Sides Dispersed Camping, Left Side

. . . Dispersed Camping, Right Side Used along with a designated road or trail to indicate limited cross-country motor vehicle use within a specific distance of that route, solely for the purpose of dispersed camping. Refer to the Dispersed Camping Table for specifics.

Other Public Roads and Trails

Highways, U.S., State, County Other Public Roads

Used to show routes not designated for motorized use by the Forest Service. Part of the reference layers showing connections to towns and cities outside the forest boundary.

DISPERSED CAMPING

Motor vehicle use off or designated roads for the purpose of dispersed camping is permitted on National Forest Lands for up to 300 feet from the centerline of the road, allowing for the same vehicles as the road allows and the same season as the road is open.

This applies to the following roads: National Forest System Roads: 88,90,94,96,98,100,102,103,109,113,116,117,120,121, 123,124,129,149,321,677,681,685,690,694,696,709, 710,712,723,731,736,739,745,750,757,758,807,845,847

Weld County Roads: 86,88,92,96,98,100,102,103,104,105,107,110,110 1/2, 111,112,113,115,116,117,119,120,124,125,126,127, 127½,128,129,131,132,133,134,135,138,141,149,153,

Dispersed camping access applies only to National Forest System land. A majority of the land within the boundaries of the Pawnee National Grassland is privately owned. Be sure you are on the National Grassland before driving off a road for camping
