FS	Basin Wide Roads - Phase 2/3 (ongoing)	500,000	Would complete the Griff Creek Bridge project, and the Gas Line road relocation.
FS	Basin Wide Trails - Phase 4 (ongoing)	870,000	Would complete Fallen Leaf Bike Path project (7 miles of new construction, 9 miles of closing and restoration, and 15 miles of reconstruction and installation of BMPs).
FS	Erosion Control Grants	2,000,000	Would provide additional stormwater grant funding to local jurisdictions.
FS	Camp Richardson Resort BMP Retrofit - Phase 3 of 3	3,250,000	Would complete full western campground area BMP retrofit.
FS	NEPA resource Inventories, Surveys, and Analysis - (ongoing)	190,000	Would complete the second cycle of monitoring for the Angora Burn Vegetation Monitoring and fund the Water Uses & Protection project - a new component in Round 12 which would focus on characterization of forests that feed municipal watersheds.
FS	Taylor Tallac Restoration - Phase 2 of 2 (planning)	0	Fully funded in Round 12 Primary Project Recommendation.
FS	Upper Truckee River Restoration, Sunset Reach	1,000,000	Would provide additional funds towards implementation of stream restoration component of project.
FS	William Kent Campground BMP Retrofit - Phase 3 of 3	0	Fully funded in Round 12 Primary Project Recommendation.
BOR	Snow Creek Restoration Project	940,000	Would fund contracting costs associated with construction and associated costs such as construction management and materials testing.
FWS	Recovery/Restoration of Lahontan Cutthroat Trout in the Tahoe Basin - (ongoing)	450,000	Would fund two years research in Lake Tahoe to determine habitat utilization of LCT and nonnative species, fund three years of assessing Lake Tahoe tributaries for restoration actions for lacustrine LCT, and add \$50,000 to Upper Truckee River nonnative trout removal.
FWS	Preventing Aquatic Invasives Species Proliferation in Lake Tahoe- Phase 6 (ongoing)	3,000,000	Would fund additional early detection and rapid response, prevention, and control and eradication.
EPA	Lake Tahoe Stormwater Tools Improvement	60,000	Would fund completion of subtasks under Task 4.
EPA	EIP Reporting Integration and Accountability Tool - Phase 4 (ongoing)	114,093	Would fund additional staffing to oversee and keep the EIP database efforts updated.
EPA	Community-Based Watershed Strategy	434,835	Would fund additional watersheds.
NRCS	Conservation Technical Assistance	115,000	Would fund an additional year of technical assistance.
