OCCUPANCY AND USE


Pursuant to Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area between Forest Development Road # 69 and Rock Creek from John Dick Bridge to Edmondson Pond; and area between Forest Development Road #4 and Copper Creek from Forest Service boundary to Copper Creek Scenic Area on Forest Development Road #236. Areas described are located on the Blue Ridge Ranger District within the Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forest. This closure order is effective from July 25, 2008 through July 25, 2013.

1. Camping. 36 CFR 261.58 (e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 21.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order.

1. A Federal, State, or Local Officer or member of any organized rescue or firefighting force in performance of their duties.
2. Persons with a permit specially authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
