Occupancy and Use – Boat Ramps


Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following prohibitions apply to Lakewood Landing, Morganton Point and Lake Blue Ridge Boat Ramps located on the Blue Ridge Ranger District within the Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forest. This closure order is effective until terminated.

1. Being on the boat ramp or in the water, which is directly over or within 30' of the center of the boat ramp for purposes other than, boat launching or boat landing.
36 CFR 261.58 (k).

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36 C.F.R, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibition:

1. Persons with a permit specially authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or firefighting force in the official performance of their duties.
