DEVELOPED RECREATION

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act or omission is prohibited at Boggs Creek and its tributaries located on the Chattooga River Ranger District within the Chattahoochee – Oconee National Forests. This closure is effective from July 25, 2013 through July 25, 2023.

1. Camping, except in designated sites. 36 CFR 261.58 (e).
2. Camping within 75 feet of Boggs Creek or its tributaries in undesignated site areas. 36 CFR 261.58 (e).
3. Parking or leaving a vehicle along Boggs Creek or its tributaries, FSR 443 and 443A, except in designated areas. 36 CFR 261.58 (g).

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36 C.F.R, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibition:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue in the official performance of their duties.
2. Persons with a permit specially authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both. Title 16 USC 551 and Title 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
