ORDER NUMBER CO—14-06

Parking – Tallulah River Road


Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act or omission is prohibited on the Tallulah River Road (FS #70) extending from the U.S. property line on the south end of FS #70 to the U.S. property line just north of Sandy Bottoms Campground located on the Chattooga River Ranger District within the Chattahoochee National-Oconee Forest. This closure is effective until terminated.

- 1) Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.58g

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36 C.F.R, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibition:

1. Persons with a permit specially authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or firefighting force in the official performance of their duties.
