

- Starting 7/6 the **Silver Lake Trail #036** and **Silver Lake** (the lake you hike to in the Lone Peak Wilderness) are closed for work that will be occurring on the dam. The trail and lake will be closed until the work on the dam is done.
  - Starting 7/13 they will be utilizing a portion of the Horse Transfer Station Trailhead for staging equipment so there may be limited parking on 7/14 and 7/15 at this trailhead.
  - 7/16 there will be short term closures while the helicopter is flying in equipment on the Silver Lake Flat Road and for the Horse Transfer Station Trailhead
- Starting 8/5 and going until 9/5 the **Timpooneke Trailhead** will be closed for reconstruction. We are *highly discouraging* people from trying to hike the Timpooneke Trail during this time period, especially on Saturdays and Holidays.
  - Alternate Trailheads include the Pine Hollow Trailhead and the Summit Trailhead both located on State Route 92. From these trailheads the Pine Hollow Trail #047, Salamander Flat Trail #150 and the Willow Hollow Trail #159 will be used to connect to the Timpooneke trail #053. While these are alternates, visitors need to keep in mind that these options add 5-7 miles round trip to your hike and that parking is also limited in these locations.
  - **Please keep these items in mind when planning your Mount Timpanogos hike:**
    - Understand where the closure area is.
    - Understand where you can legally park your vehicle.
    - Do not park your vehicle in a manner that impedes the flow of traffic on roads, in the campgrounds and in the trailhead. Vehicles parked in a manner that impedes the flow of traffic will be towed.
    - Plan your visit so that you avoid Saturdays and holidays.
    - While the Mount Timpanogos Trail #052 is another option, the Mount Timpanogos trailhead also experiences extremely high use on Saturdays and holidays and cannot accommodate the normal visitation on those days.
    - Realize that if the trailheads are full, that you will need to change your plans by coming back later in the day, scheduling a different day to do your hike, or finding an alternate trail to hike.
- There will also be a Half Marathon on 7/28 from the Tibble Fork Reservoir down the mouth of AF canyon. It will begin at 6:00 am and they hope to have all the cleanup done by 10:00.
- Also the Tour of Utah will be going over the Alpine Loop on 8/11 between 1:00-2:00 and there will be a rolling closure while the bikers go over the loop.
