Special Order Use Restriction White River National Forest Eagle / Holy Cross Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) (b) the following acts are prohibited on National Forest lands in Township 7S and Range 80W. This prohibition is in addition to those enumerated in subpart A, Part 261, title 36CFR, become effective immediately, and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

36 CFR 261.50 - Special Orders:

Travel off system roads and trails by entering or occupying, National Forest System lands in Township 7S, Range 80W which is closed for the protection of public health and safety (36 CFR261.50) as described on the attached map (Travel Restriction Order Map)

The reason for the closure is to provide for public safety by preventing contact with potential asbestos located in the southern portion of the cantonment area of Camp Hale National Historic site.

Pursuant to 36 CFR.261. 50 the following acts are exempt from this restriction:

- (1) Persons traveling on the open system roads and trails within the closure area Roads: 702; 708; 714; 716; 716.1B; 726; 741; 716.1A; 726.1A; N714W.13; and Trail #2108.
- (2) Unless the closure area is adequately covered with at least 1 foot of snow.
- (3) Persons with a permit or a Federal contract specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (4) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
