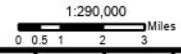


Clackamas River Ranger District Incidental Use Mushroom Map

WHITE areas are OPEN to mushroom picking in the Mt. Hood National Forest. All GRAY areas are CLOSED to mushroom picking. No COMMERCIAL harvest PERMITS are no longer required for 1 GALLON or less of mushrooms for personal use, up to 10 GALLONS per year
