## **Habituated Mountain Goats in Area**



Goats in this area are closely approaching and following people and entering campsites. Habituated wildlife can become aggressive. Goats have sharp, lethal horns.

- Stay at least 50 yards (1/2 length of football field) away from all wildlife.
- If a goat approaches you, slowly move away to keep a safe distance. If the goat follows, be prepared to chase it off by yelling, waving arms and clothing, or throwing rocks!
- Goats crave salts. **Use the toilets where available.**Otherwise, urinate on bare rocks, between rocks or locations inaccessible to goats, at least 100 feet away from trails or campsites. Do not leave sweaty clothes unattended.
- Male goats become more aggressive during their breeding season, October – December.

Following these guidelines will help protect you and the goats.
